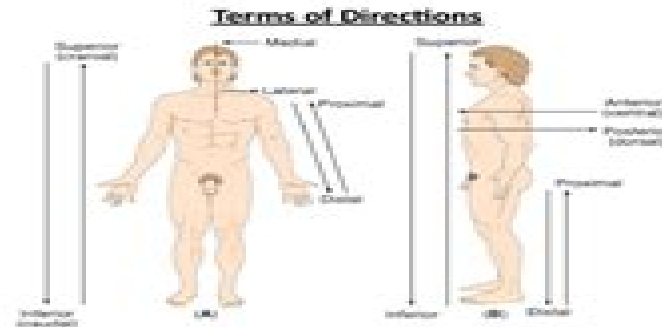


Anatomy and Physiology Chapter 1 Review Notes

Anatomy: Anatomy is the study of the STRUCTURE or morphology of the body and how the body parts are organized.

Physiology: Physiology is the study of the FUNCTION of body parts, what they do and how they do it.

Pathology: Pathology is the study of the diseases of the human body



1. **Superior (cranial):** superior means uppermost or above
ex) The head is superior to the neck
ex) The thoracic cavity is superior to the abdominal cavity.
2. **Inferior (caudal):** inferior means lowermost or below
ex) The foot is inferior to the ankle
ex) The ankle is inferior to the knee
3. **Anterior (ventral):** Anterior means towards the front
ex) the mammary glands are anterior to the chest wall
4. **Posterior (dorsal):** posterior means towards the back
ex) The esophagus is posterior to the trachea
5. **Cranial (cephalad):** Cranial means towards the head. Cranial is synonymous with superior
ex) The thoracic cavity lies cephalad (superior) to the abdominopelvic cavity
6. **Medial:** Medial means nearest the midline of the body
ex) The nose is in a medial position on the face
