CHARACTERISTICS OF THE BODY PLAN

- 1. **Unicellular** - Single-celled organisms.
- 2. **Multicellular** - Multi-celled organisms.
- 3. **Prokaryotic** - Lack a nucleus.
- 4. **Eukaryotic** - Have a nucleus.
- 5. **Autotrophic** - Produce their own food.
- 6. **Heterotrophic** - Consume other organisms for food.
- 7. **Asexual** - Reproduce without a mate.
- 8. **Sexual** - Reproduce with a mate.
- 9. **Parthenogenesis** - Asexual reproduction without fertilization.
- 10. **Cloning** - Producing a genetically identical copy.
- 11. **Regeneration** - Ability to regrow lost parts.
- 12. **Stem cells** - Undifferentiated cells that can become specialized.
- 13. **Cell differentiation** - Cells becoming specialized for different functions.
- 14. **Cell division** - Process of a cell dividing into two.
- 15. **Cell growth** - Increase in cell size.
- 16. **Cell death** - Programmed cell death (apoptosis).
- 17. **Cell signaling** - Communication between cells.
- 18. **Cell adhesion** - Cells sticking together.

ORIGIN OF LIFE

The origin of life is a topic of ongoing research. The most widely accepted theory is the **abiogenesis** theory, which suggests that life arose from non-living matter through a series of chemical reactions. Other theories include the **biogenesis** theory, which suggests that life arose from pre-existing life, and the **panspermia** theory, which suggests that life was brought to Earth from elsewhere in the universe.

CELL PARTS AND REGION

Cells are the basic units of life. They are composed of various parts and regions that work together to maintain the cell's function. The main parts of a cell are the **cell membrane**, **cytoplasm**, **nucleus**, and **organelles**.

NERVOUS SYSTEM

FUNCTION

- 1. **Control** - The nervous system controls the body's activities.
- 2. **Coordination** - The nervous system coordinates the body's activities.
- 3. **Communication** - The nervous system communicates with other parts of the body.
- 4. **Response** - The nervous system responds to stimuli.
- 5. **Regulation** - The nervous system regulates the body's internal environment.
- 6. **Protection** - The nervous system protects the body from harm.
- 7. **Integration** - The nervous system integrates information from the environment and the body.
- 8. **Adaptation** - The nervous system adapts the body to its environment.
- 9. **Homeostasis** - The nervous system maintains the body's internal balance.
- 10. **Survival** - The nervous system ensures the survival of the organism.

STRUCTURE

- 1. **Brain** - The central control center of the nervous system.
- 2. **Spinal cord** - A long, thin structure that carries messages between the brain and the rest of the body.
- 3. **Nerves** - Bundles of fibers that carry messages between the brain, spinal cord, and the rest of the body.
- 4. **Neurons** - The basic units of the nervous system that transmit information.
- 5. **Glial cells** - Support cells that provide nutrients and protection for neurons.
- 6. **Synapses** - Junctions between neurons where messages are passed.
- 7. **Receptors** - Structures that detect stimuli and send messages to the nervous system.
- 8. **Effectors** - Structures that carry out the nervous system's commands.
- 9. **Reflex arcs** - Simple pathways that allow the body to respond quickly to stimuli.
- 10. **Complex pathways** - More intricate pathways that involve multiple neurons and brain regions.

INTERNAL SYSTEMS OF THE BODY

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- 1. **Respiratory system** - The system that takes in oxygen and removes carbon dioxide.
- 2. **Circulatory system** - The system that transports blood and nutrients throughout the body.
- 3. **Digestive system** - The system that breaks down food into nutrients that the body can use.
- 4. **Excretory system** - The system that removes waste from the body.
- 5. **Reproductive system** - The system that produces offspring.
- 6. **Immune system** - The system that defends the body against disease.
- 7. **Endocrine system** - The system that produces hormones that regulate the body's functions.
- 8. **Nervous system** - The system that controls the body's activities.
- 9. **Musculoskeletal system** - The system that provides structure and movement to the body.
- 10. **Integumentary system** - The system that covers the body and protects it from the environment.
