

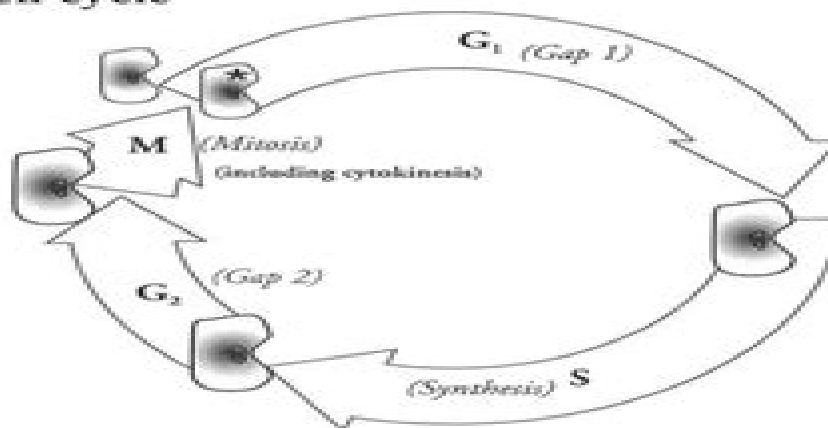
The Cell Cycle

In multicellular organisms, different types of cells have different roles and need to complete specific tasks. For example, a cell that isn't large enough is not useful for storing nutrients for later, but a cell that is too large will not be useful for transportation through a tiny capillary. In this activity, you will learn about the seasons of a cell's life, and in turn better understand how organisms function.

book provides a comprehensive overview of the cell cycle regulation and development in Alphaproteobacteria. Cell cycle and cellular differentiation are fascinating biological phenomena that are highly regulated in all organisms. In the last decades many laboratories around the world have been investigating these processes in Alphaproteobacteria. This bacterial class comprises important bacterial species studied by fundamental and applied research. The complexity of cell cycle regulation and many examples of cellular differentiations in this bacterial group represent the main motives of this book. The book starts with discussing the regulation of cell cycle in alphaproteobacterial species from a system biology perspective. The following chapters specifically focus on the model species *Caulobacter crescentus*, multiple layers of regulation from transcriptional cascades to proteolysis and dynamic subcellular regulation of cell cycle regulators. In addition, the cell division process, chromosome segregation and growth of the cell envelope is described in detail. The last part of the book covers examples of non *Caulobacter* alphaproteobacterial models such as *Agrobacterium tumefaciens*, *Brucella* species and *Sinorhizobium meliloti* and also discusses possible applications. Phosphoinositides have been known to play a role in cell signalling since the 1950s and since then lipid signals have been discovered to play a role in many different cellular functions. *Biology of Phosphoinositides* is not a historical account but a review of the current opinions of lipid signalling research with the emphasis on the integration of the use of lipid signals in signal transduction and membrane trafficking. These two areas have traditionally been seen as separate but now anyone ignoring one area at the expense of the other does so at their peril. The regulation of phospholipase C and its isozymes, phospholipase D, the phosphoinositide 3 kinases, chloride channel conductance by inositol 1,3,4,5,6-tetrakisphosphate and of cytoskeletal protein activity by inositol lipids are all covered in depth. There is specific discussion of the PH and FYVE lipid binding domains that allow lipids to control the movement, location and activation state of membrane proteins. The central issue of the control of synthesis, translocation and degradation of phosphoinositides is also given due coverage. For too long lipids have been seen as a backwater of biology and an uninteresting topic to study. However, their central role in cell function is now properly recognized and the *Biology of Phosphoinositides* will serve as an enjoyable and intriguing introduction to what these slippery molecules can achieve.

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
