What is airspace?

On any given day, more than 87,000 flights are in the skies in the United States. Prosegou! To handle all of this traffic, the FAA has developed what is called the National Airspace System. The atmosphere is divided up into unique sectors, with each sector's properties based upon that area's level of traffic and any particular needs of that area.

How airspace gets it classification.

The National Airspace System divides up the classifications of airspace based on:

- The level of air traffic
- 2. The nature of the operations conducted
- 3. The level of safety required
- 4. National and public interest

Busy airports like Chicago's O'Hare will be classified differently from a single-runway airport in the middle of no-where. Areas like the Kennedy Space Center and Washington DC have unique rules, which restrict or prohibit aircraft from flying in that area due to safety and/or security reasons.

Categories and types of airspace

There are two categories of airspace or airspace areas: Regulatory and Non-Regulatory. Regulatory airspace has a set of specific regulations that govern that area; whereas Non-Regulatory airspace is just used to advise or warn pilots of the operations that are conducted within the airspace

- 1. Regulatory airspace consists of:
 - a. Classes A, B, C, D, E, G
 - b. Restricted areas
 - c. Prohibited areas
- Non-Regulatory airspace consists of:
 - Military operations areas (MOAs)
