Physiology

The scientific study of the function of the human body

Structural levels

Also known as the levels of organization of the human body

- 1. Chemical level - study of the chemical composition of the body
- 2. Cellular level - study of the structure and function of cells
- 3. Tissue level - study of the structure and function of tissues
- 4. Organ level - study of the structure and function of organs
- 5. System level - study of the structure and function of body systems
- 6. Organism level - study of the structure and function of the whole body

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids

Extracellular fluid - fluid outside the cell

Intracellular fluid - fluid inside the cell

Interstitial fluid - fluid between cells

Blood plasma - fluid part of blood

Organic fluids - fluids containing organic molecules

Inorganic fluids - fluids containing inorganic molecules

Electrolytes - substances that conduct electricity

Non-electrolytes - substances that do not conduct electricity

Acids - substances that release hydrogen ions

Bases - substances that accept hydrogen ions

pH - measure of acidity or basicity

Homeostasis - the body's ability to maintain a stable internal environment

Feedback loops - mechanisms that regulate homeostasis

Positive feedback - amplifies a response

Negative feedback - reduces a response

Set point - the desired value of a variable

Range - the acceptable range of values for a variable

Stimulus - a change in the environment that triggers a response

Receptor - a structure that detects a stimulus

Effector - a structure that responds to a stimulus

Response - the body's reaction to a stimulus

Adaptation - a change in the body that improves its ability to survive in its environment

Evolution - the process of change in the characteristics of a population over time

Speciation - the process of new species formation

Extinction - the disappearance of a species

Conservation - the protection of natural resources

Endangered species - a species at risk of extinction

Keystone species - a species that has a large effect on its environment

Bioindicator - an organism that can be used to monitor the health of an ecosystem

Bioremediation - the use of living organisms to clean up pollution

Genetic engineering - the manipulation of an organism's genes

Cloning - the production of a genetically identical copy of an organism

Stem cells - undifferentiated cells that can become any type of cell

Transgenic organisms - organisms that have been genetically modified

CRISPR-Cas9 - a gene editing technology

Gene therapy - the treatment of genetic disorders

Artificial intelligence - the simulation of human intelligence

Machine learning - a type of artificial intelligence

Deep learning - a type of machine learning

Neural networks - a type of deep learning

Computer vision - a type of artificial intelligence

Natural language processing - a type of artificial intelligence

Speech recognition - a type of natural language processing

Machine translation - a type of natural language processing

Image classification - a type of computer vision

Object detection - a type of computer vision

Facial recognition - a type of computer vision

Handwriting recognition - a type of computer vision

CELLS

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body

Prokaryotic cells - cells without a nucleus

Eukaryotic cells - cells with a nucleus

Animal cells - cells from animals

Plant cells - cells from plants

Fungal cells - cells from fungi

Bacterial cells - cells from bacteria

Viral cells - cells from viruses

Protozoan cells - cells from protozoa

Algal cells - cells from algae

Fungal hyphae - the thread-like structures of fungi

Spores - reproductive cells of fungi

Mycelium - the mass of hyphae in a fungus

Conidia - asexual spores of fungi

Zygotes - sexual spores of fungi

Ascospores - spores of fungi in an ascus

Basidiospores - spores of fungi on a basidium

Trilete spores - spores with three lines of thickening

Stratified squamous epithelium - a type of epithelium

Simple cuboidal epithelium - a type of epithelium

Transitional epithelium - a type of epithelium

Endothelium - the lining of blood vessels

Mesothelium - the lining of body cavities

Epithelium - the lining of organs and surfaces

Connective tissue - the tissue that supports other tissues

Adipose tissue - a type of connective tissue

Cartilage - a type of connective tissue

Bone - a type of connective tissue

Blood - a type of connective tissue

Lymph - a type of connective tissue

Interstitial fluid - the fluid between cells

Plasma - the liquid part of blood

Red blood cells - cells that carry oxygen

White blood cells - cells that fight infection

Platelets - cells that help with clotting

Neutrophils - a type of white blood cell

Lymphocytes - a type of white blood cell

Macrophages - a type of white blood cell

Dendritic cells - a type of white blood cell

Regulatory T cells - a type of white blood cell

Helper T cells - a type of white blood cell

Cytotoxic T cells - a type of white blood cell

Natural killer cells - a type of white blood cell

Memory B cells - a type of white blood cell

Memory T cells - a type of white blood cell

Antibodies - proteins that fight infection

Antigens - substances that trigger an immune response

Immunization - the process of making a person immune to a disease

Vaccine - a substance that stimulates an immune response

Antigen presentation - the process of showing an antigen to a T cell

Major histocompatibility complex - a set of genes that code for proteins that present antigens

T cell receptor - a protein on the surface of a T cell that recognizes an antigen

CD4 molecule - a protein on the surface of a T cell that binds to the CD80/86 molecule

CD8 molecule - a protein on the surface of a T cell that binds to the CD80/86 molecule

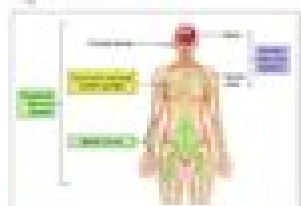
Interleukin-2 - a cytokine that stimulates T cell growth

Interferon-gamma - a cytokine that activates macrophages

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

Functions

- 1. Ventilation - the process of moving air in and out of the lungs
- 2. External respiration - the exchange of gases between the lungs and the blood
- 3. Internal respiration - the exchange of gases between the blood and the cells
- 4. Gas transport - the movement of gases in the blood
- 5. pH regulation - the maintenance of the body's acid-base balance



Structure

The respiratory system is composed of the following parts:

Nasal cavity - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Oral cavity - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Pharynx - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Larynx - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Trachea - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Bronchi - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Alveoli - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth

Capillaries - the part of the respiratory system that leads to the mouth
