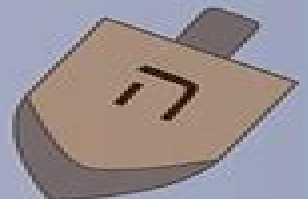
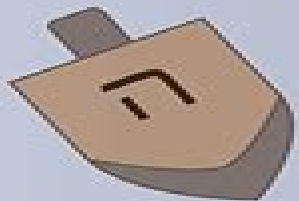

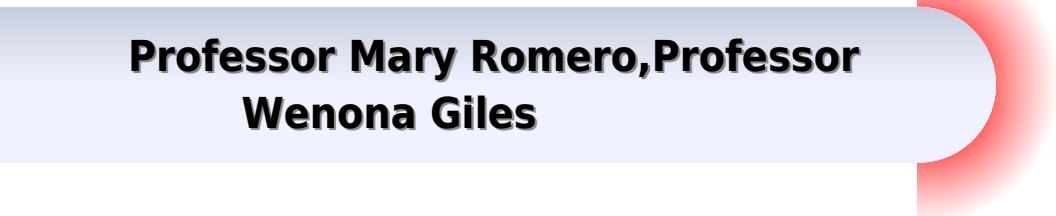

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Judaism in Transition Carmel U. Chiswick, 2014-06-04 At the core of Judaism stands a body of traditions that have remained consistent over millennia Yet the practice of these rituals has varied widely across historical and cultural contexts In Judaism in Transition Carmel U Chiswick draws on her Jewish upbringing her journey as a Jewish parent and her perspective as an economist to consider how incentives affect the ways that mainstream American Jews have navigated and continue to manage the conflicting demands of everyday life and religious observance Arguing that economics is a blind spot in our understanding of religion Chiswick blends her personal experiences with economic analysis to illustrate the cost of Jewish participation financially and more importantly in terms of time and effort The history of American Jews is almost always told as a success story in the secular world Chiswick recasts this story as one of innovation in order to maintain a distinctive Jewish culture while keeping pace with the steady march of American life She shows how tradeoffs often made on an individual and deeply personal level produce the brand of Judaism which predominates in America today Along the way Chiswick explores salient and controversial topics from intermarriage to immigration and from egalitarianism to connections with Israel At once a portrait of American Jewish culture and a work that outlines how economic decisions affect religion Judaism in Transition shows how changes in our economic environment will affect the Jewish community for decades to come

When Care Work Goes Global Professor Mary Romero, Professor Wenona Giles, 2014-09-28 Women who migrate into domestic labour and care work are the single largest female occupational group migrating globally at present Their participation in global migration systems has been acknowledged but remains under theorized Specifically the impacts of women migrating into care work in the receiving as well as the sending societies are profound altering gendered aspects of both societies We know that migration systems link the women who migrate and the households and organizations that employ domestic and care workers but how do these migration systems work and more importantly what are their impacts on the sending as well as the receiving societies How do sending and receiving societies regulate women s migration for care work and how do these labour market exchanges take place How is reproductive labour changed in the receiving society when it is done by women who are subject to multifaceted othering racializing processes A must buy acquisition *When Care Work Goes Global* will be an extremely valuable addition for course adoption in migration labour and gender courses taught in Sociology Anthropology Geography Women s Studies Area Studies and International Development Studies

Labor in Israel Jonathan Preminger, 2018-04-15 Using a comprehensive analysis of the wave of organizing that swept the country starting in 2007 *Labor in Israel* investigates the changing political status of organized labor in the context of changes to Israel s political economy including liberalization the rise of non union labor organizations the influx of migrant labor and Israel s complex relations with the Palestinians Through his discussion of organized labor s relationship to the political community and its nationalist political role Preminger demonstrates that organized labor has lost the powerful status it enjoyed for much of Israel s history Despite the weakening of trade unions and the Histadrut however he shows the ways in which the fragmentation of labor representation has created opportunities for those previously excluded from the labor movement regime Organized labor is now trying to renegotiate its place in contemporary Israel a society that no longer accepts labor s longstanding claim to be the representative of the people As such Preminger concludes that organized labor in Israel is in a transitional and unsettled phase in which new marginal initiatives new organizations and new alliances that have blurred the boundaries of the sphere of labor have not yet consolidated into clear structures of representation or accepted patterns of political interaction
