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University Community Engagement and Lifelong Learning Julia Preece, 2017-07-13 This book offers a conceptual re-think of how university community engagement functions as a lifelong learning resource for communities. While having a specific focus on the South African context, it has important implications for other universities which are concerned with their communities and makes a compelling argument for the university as a public good in spite of current trends towards marketization and commodification of higher education. The book draws on a theoretical framework of capabilities asset-based community development and the adult learning concept of dialogue to propose a model whereby the boundary walls of the university become metaphorically porous so that community members feel free to interact with the university as equal members of society. A historical outline of African universities is provided as well as an exploration of the evolution of terms for community engagement, service learning and learning cities and an examination of the policy and practice implications for the ideological model of a porous university.

Nyamnjoh, 2016-04-18 This book on rights, entitlements and citizenship in post-apartheid South Africa shows how the playing field has not been as levelled as presumed by some and how racism and its benefits persist. Through everyday interactions and experiences of university students and professors, it explores the question of race in a context still plagued by remnants of apartheid inequality and perceptions of inferiority and inadequacy among the majority black population. In education, black voices and concerns go largely unheard as circles of privilege are continually regenerated and added onto a layered and deep history of cultivation of black pain. These issues are examined against the backdrop of organised student protests sweeping through the country's universities with a renewed clamour for transformation around a rallying cry of Black Lives Matter. The nuanced complexity of this insightful analysis of the Rhodes Must Fall movement elicits compelling questions about the attractions and dangers of exclusionary articulations of belonging. What could a grand imperialist like the stripling Uitlander or foreigner of yesteryear Sir Cecil John Rhodes possibly have in common with the present-day nimble-footed makwerekwere from Africa north of the Limpopo? The answer Nyamnjoh suggests is to be found in how human mobility relentlessly tests the boundaries of citizenship.

Decolonisation in Universities Jonathan Jansen, 2019-08-01 In this collection of case studies and stories from the field, South African scholars come together to trade stories on how to decolonise the university. Shortly after the giant bronze statue of Cecil John Rhodes came down at the University of Cape Town, student protestors called for the decolonisation of universities. It was a word hardly heard in South Africa's struggle lexicon and many asked: What exactly is decolonisation? This edited volume brings together the best minds in curriculum theory to address this important question. In the process, several critical questions are raised: Is decolonisation simply a slogan for addressing other pressing concerns on campuses and in society?
