1. Find the equation of the line passing through the points $(-2, 3)$ and $(4, -1)$.

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Slope } m &= \frac{y_2 - y_1}{x_2 - x_1} = \frac{-1 - 3}{4 - (-2)} = \frac{-4}{6} = -\frac{2}{3} \\ \text{Equation of line } y - y_1 &= m(x - x_1) \\ y - 3 &= -\frac{2}{3}(x + 2) \\ y - 3 &= -\frac{2}{3}x - \frac{4}{3} \\ y &= -\frac{2}{3}x - \frac{4}{3} + 3 \\ y &= -\frac{2}{3}x + \frac{5}{3} \end{aligned}$$

2. Find the equation of the line passing through the points $(1, 2)$ and $(3, 4)$.

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Slope } m &= \frac{4 - 2}{3 - 1} = \frac{2}{2} = 1 \\ \text{Equation of line } y - y_1 &= m(x - x_1) \\ y - 2 &= 1(x - 1) \\ y - 2 &= x - 1 \\ y &= x - 1 + 2 \\ y &= x + 1 \end{aligned}$$

3. Find the equation of the line passing through the points $(-1, 5)$ and $(2, 1)$.

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Slope } m &= \frac{1 - 5}{2 - (-1)} = \frac{-4}{3} = -\frac{4}{3} \\ \text{Equation of line } y - y_1 &= m(x - x_1) \\ y - 5 &= -\frac{4}{3}(x + 1) \\ y - 5 &= -\frac{4}{3}x - \frac{4}{3} \\ y &= -\frac{4}{3}x - \frac{4}{3} + 5 \\ y &= -\frac{4}{3}x + \frac{11}{3} \end{aligned}$$

4. Find the equation of the line passing through the points $(0, 3)$ and $(4, 0)$.

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Slope } m &= \frac{0 - 3}{4 - 0} = \frac{-3}{4} = -\frac{3}{4} \\ \text{Equation of line } y - y_1 &= m(x - x_1) \\ y - 3 &= -\frac{3}{4}(x - 0) \\ y - 3 &= -\frac{3}{4}x \\ y &= -\frac{3}{4}x + 3 \end{aligned}$$
