mathematics teaching in secondary schools in England focusing on the following issues the take up of science and mathematics at GCSE and A level the provision of careers advice to students problems in the recruitment and retention of teachers the quality of teaching methods and the role of continuing professional development The Committee finds that effective science teaching in schools is essential both in order to ensure a satisfactory general level of scientific literacy in society and to enable the next generation of scientists and engineers to progress into higher education and beyond It argues that the current examination system forces students to study an excessively narrow range of subjects at too early an age and it recommends that the Government should reconsider the Tomlinson proposals for a broader diploma based system for 14 19 year old students based on the International Baccalaureate This would ensure that students receive a more rounded education and are not made to over specialise before they are able to see the merits of studying science and mathematics Concerns are also raised about the shortage of science teachers particularly specialist physics and chemistry teachers the quality of careers advice in schools and the importance of practical science in schools

Hughes,2016-10-17 Capitalism likes us to believe in the steady inevitable march of progress from the abacus to the iPad But the historical record tells of innumerable roads not taken all of which could have led to better more equal worlds and still can Academic and activist Bob Hughes puts flesh on the bones of the idea that another world is possible using as evidence the technology that capitalism claims as quintessentially its own the computer in all its forms Contrary to popular belief capitalism does not do innovation well instead suppressing or appropriating it This book shows that great innovations have never emerged from capitalism per se but always from the utopian moments that occur behind the capitalist s back And when it does embrace an innovation the results are often the diametric opposite of what the innovators intended In this thorough and meticulous work Hughes argues that if we only prioritized equality over materialism then superior and more diverse technologies would emerge leading to a richer more sustainable world Bob Hughes is an academic activist and author Formerly he taught electronic media Oxford Brookes University and now spends his time researching and campaigning against inequality He is author of Dust or Magic a book for digital multimedia workers about how people do good stuff with computers He is a member of No One is Illegal which campaigns for the total abolition of immigration controls for whom he has written many articles

Every year millions of families are affected by the imprisonment of a family member Children of imprisoned parents alone can be counted in millions in the USA and in Europe It is a bewildering fact that while we have had prisons for centuries and the deprivation of liberty has been a central pillar in the Western mode of punishment since the early nineteenth century we have only relatively recently embarked upon a serious discussion of the severe effects of imprisonment for the families and relatives of offenders and the implications this has for society This book draws together some of the excellent research that addresses the impact of criminal justice and incarceration in particular upon the families of offenders It assembles examples

of recent and ongoing studies from eight different countries in order to not only learn about the secondary effects and collateral consequences of imprisonment but also to understand what the experiences and lived realities of prisoners families means for the sociology of punishment and our broader understanding of criminal justice systems While punishment and society scholarship has gained significant ground in recent years it has often remained silent on the ways in which the families of prisoners are affected by our practices of punishment This book provides evidence of the importance of including families within this scholarship and explores themes of legitimacy citizenship human rights marginalization exclusion and inequality

The Schenley Experiment Jake Oresick, 2017-04-14 The Schenley Experiment is the story of Pittsburgh's first public high school a social incubator in a largely segregated city that was highly even improbably successful throughout its 156 year existence Established in 1855 as Central High School and reorganized in 1916 Schenley High School was a model of innovative public education and an ongoing experiment in diversity Its graduates include Andy Warhol actor Bill Nunn and

jazz virtuoso Earl Hines and its prestigious academic program and pensions lured such teachers as future Pulitzer Prize winner Willa Cather The subject of investment as well as destructive neglect the school reflects the history of the city of Pittsburgh and provides a study in both the best and worst of urban public education practices there and across the Rust Belt Integrated decades before Brown v Board of Education Schenley succumbed to default segregation during the white flight of the 1970s it rose again to prominence in the late 1980s when parents camped out in six day long lines to enroll their children in visionary superintendent Richard C Wallace s reinvigorated school Although the historic triangular building was a cornerstone of its North Oakland neighborhood and a showpiece for the city of Pittsburgh officials closed the school in 2008 citing over 50 million in necessary renovations a controversial event that captured national attention Schenley alumnus Jake Oresick tells this story through interviews historical documents and hundreds of first person accounts drawn from a community indelibly tied to the school A memorable important work of local and educational history his book is a case study of desegregation magnet education and the changing nature and legacies of America s oldest public schools **Vascular**
