The Design of Frontier Spaces Carolyn Loeb, Andreas Luescher, 2016-03-09 In a globalizing world frontiers may be in flux but they remain as significant as ever New borders are established even as old borders are erased Beyond lines on maps however borders are spatial zones in which distinctive architectural graphic and other design elements are deployed to signal the nature of the space and to guide if not actually control behaviour and social relations within it This volume unpacks how manipulations of space and design in frontier zones historically as well as today set the stage for specific kinds of interactions and convey meanings about these sites and the experiences they embody Frontier zones organize an array of functions to facilitate the passage of goods information and people and to define and control access Bringing together studies from Asia Africa the Middle East Europe and North America this collection of essays casts a wide net to consider borders of diverse sorts Investigations of contemporary political frontiers are set within the context of examinations of historical borders borders that have existed within cities and virtual borders This range allows for reflection on shifts in how frontier zones are articulated and the impermanence of border emplacements as well as on likely scenarios for future frontiers This text is unique in bringing together a number of scholarly perspectives in the arts and humanities to examine how spatial and architectural design decisions convey meaning shape or abet specific social practices and stage memories of frontier zones that no longer function as such It joins and expands discussions in social science disciplines in which considerations of border practices tend to overlook the role of built form and material culture more broadly in representing social practices and meanings

Motherhood in Johannesburg: Mapping the experiences and moral geographies of women and their children in the city Alexandra Parker, Margot Rubin, 2017-11-30 South African cities were designed and legislated to enforce spatial marginalisation of Africans coloureds and Indians to peripheral urban settlements The legacy of this intentionally constructed racially segregated space has been reinforced in the post apartheid period by market forces around property prices informal settlement of land and the unintended consequences of state housing policy amongst other factors Patterns of race based spatial marginalisation have also been overlaid by income and gender factors creating hostile conditions for women and poor women in particular Whilst there is a rich mine of literature on spatial exclusions due to race very little study has focused on the gendered spatial experiences of women and more particularly mothers in South African cities

Mothers sustain a number of multifaceted roles through and beyond the care of and provision for their children. They engage in multiple spheres of work, home, education, community, and politics. Straddling these various realms, mothers are increasingly active users of a diversity of city spaces. In some cases, the daily routines of mothers are confined within a single neighbourhood, but most often, mothers enact their many roles on a day-to-day basis in many different areas of the city. The nature of motherhood as both a relationship of care and a role constructed in society and highly unequal urban conditions often impose heavy burdens, financial, temporal, and emotional. However, the choices mothers make in the city by traversing diverse spaces in order to fulfil their multiple roles and the responsibilities and costs this inflicts is not well understood. This Occasional Paper speaks to this gap by exploring the spatial dynamics of mothers in Johannesburg. It investigates how women who self-identify as mothers navigate their own and their families' daily lives in the city in facing a variety of challenges and obstacles. Methodologically, the research involved studying the everyday practices and experiences of 25 mothers in the city who agreed to in-depth interviews and mapping exercises. The participants were a diverse group in terms of geographic location, income, race, age, and family situation. The women narrated their daily lives and the routes they took through various places and spaces that made up their everyday experiences of the city. They discussed their decision-making around the choice of home, work, school, shopping, and recreation, and detailed the social and spatial dynamics of their support networks. Exploring these moral geographies of motherhood provides valuable insights into a group of people who engage the city extensively in ways that are under-recognised. In turn, understanding the spatial negotiations that typify mothers' lives exposes the depth of spatial inequality and poor urban management of our city region in new ways. This Occasional Paper is the result of a partnership between the South African Research Chair in Spatial Analysis and City Planning (SA-CP) and the GCRO, and specifically involved a collaboration between researchers Yasmeen Dinath, Margot Rubin, and Alexandra Parker. The insights presented here reflect results from a first phase of research that will be deepened through a larger study in 2018.

This however neglects the multiple ways in which the wider politics of capital accumulation and distribution drive divergent forms of transformation in different urban places In order to unpack the politics that shapes differential urban development this book focuses on East Africa as the global urban frontier the least urbanized but fastest urbanizing region in the world Drawing on a decade of research spanning three case study countries Ethiopia Rwanda and Uganda *Politics and the Urban Frontier* provides the first sustained book length comparative analysis of urban development trajectories in Eastern Africa and the political dynamics that underpin them Through a focus on infrastructure investment urban propertyscapes street level trading economies and urban political protest it offers a multi scalar historically grounded and interdisciplinary analysis of the urban transformations unfolding in the world s most dynamic crucible of urban change

Writing Windhoek Ellison Tjirera, 2025-10-01 Small cities have something to offer in terms of theoretical resources and renewing our understanding of urban life In other words all cities do matter and are therefore worthy of drawing from Condemning insignificant cities to oblivion is a travesty that will leave urban studies poorer Importantly no city is reducible to one register in the representation of its essence In *Writing Windhoek* Ellison Tjirera makes an attempt to revivify the Capital city of Namibia and treat it as an idea meriting a closer examination and reflection In illuminating the essence of Windhoek s cityness this book traces its history of spatial segregation an imprint that continues to define contemporary city life The cultural memory of Windhoek is analysed as a way of accessing what is otherwise a not so obvious strand through which to understand a city that has escaped a sustained scholarly rendition In his further layering of the city Tjirera provides a portrait of Windhoek through urban fantasies regimes of the legal and how migration is implicated in shaping social heterogeneity and concatenations of various urban rhythms

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
