Civil Liberties

- Civil liberties: limitations on government power, intended to protect freedoms that the government may not legally intrude on
- Civil rights- guarantees that the government officials will treat people equally and that decisions will be made on the basis of morit rather than personal characteristics.
- Constitution Article I Section 9 limits the power of congress:
 - Prohibitin passage of bills of attainder
 - Prohibiting ex post facto laws.
 - Limiting ability of congress to suspend the writ of habeas corpus
- Bill of attainder- law that convicts or punishes someone for a crime without that
- Ex post facto law- can be used to punish crimes that were not crimes at the time they were committed, or increase severity of punishment after the fact
- Whit of habeas corpus- neutral judge must be used to decide whether someone has been lawfully detained
- National security can trump individual liberties.
