Dietary and Nutritional Indices and Chronic Diseases Sorayya Kheikouri, Mohammad Alizadeh, Masayo Nakamori Rossignoli, 2024-03-06 Chronic diseases such as diabetes cardiovascular diseases and cancers are known as a substantive worldwide challenge for health systems and are major contributors to mortality and morbidity According to the World Health Organization 71% of all deaths and 63.8% of Disability Adjusted Life Years DALYs are attributed to chronic diseases The composition of a diet influences health status and affects the occurrence and severity of chronic diseases As different components of a diet correlate and interact with one another addressing only individual dietary constituents does not usually help in analyzing the extent to which diets may prevent or contribute to the development or progress of chronic diseases In recent years the concept of dietary indices has received more attention by both researchers and clinicians and is used as a means to capture the overall effect of a diet on a specific disease or a group of related illnesses These indices are

nutritionally derived mathematical algorithms which are developed on the bases of useful or detrimental nutrients and or food groups Thus the indices are frequently used to elucidate proper aspects of a specific diet such as quality diversity anti inflammatory anti oxidative and or anti glycation potential and acid load Examples include the dietary inflammatory index DII dietary total antioxidant capacity DTAC healthy eating index HEI dietary acid load and so forth There is accumulating evidence indicating a link between scores of dietary and nutritional indices and health outcomes

The aim of this Research Topic is to explore the current status and future direction of interprofessional care teams. We are open to receiving articles that explore interprofessional collaboration in the context of various clinical diagnoses including chronic pain, cancer, neurological ailments, psychiatric problems, or cardiorespiratory conditions.
