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Normal Heart Rates*

Age	Awake rate	Sleeping rate (bradycardia)
Neonate	100-200	90-160
Infant	100-160	90-160
Toddler	90-140	80-120
Preschooler	80-120	60-100
School-age child	70-110	50-90
Adolescent	60-100	50-90

*Always consider the patient's normal range and clinical condition. Heart rate will normally increase with fever or stress.

Normal Respiratory Rates*

Age	Rate (breaths/min)
Infant	30-50
Toddler	22-32
Preschooler	20-30
School-age child	18-26
Adolescent	12-20

*Consider the patient's normal range. The child's respiratory rate is expected to increase in the presence of fever or stress.
