



The Digestive System

What is the digestive system?

The digestive system, or **gastrointestinal tract**, is a tract of organs that is responsible for digesting and absorbing nutrients from food. Food enters through the mouth, is broken down in the stomach, and then moves through the small intestine, where nutrients are absorbed. The digestive system also includes accessory organs that help in the process, such as the liver, pancreas, and gallbladder.



Liver, pancreas & gallbladder

After leaving the stomach, digested material enters the duodenum, the first part of the small intestine, where it is mixed with bile secreted by the **liver**. The liver is a large organ on the right side of the abdomen. It produces bile, which is stored in the **gallbladder**. The pancreas, located behind the stomach, produces pancreatic juice, which is also secreted into the duodenum.



Layers of large intestine



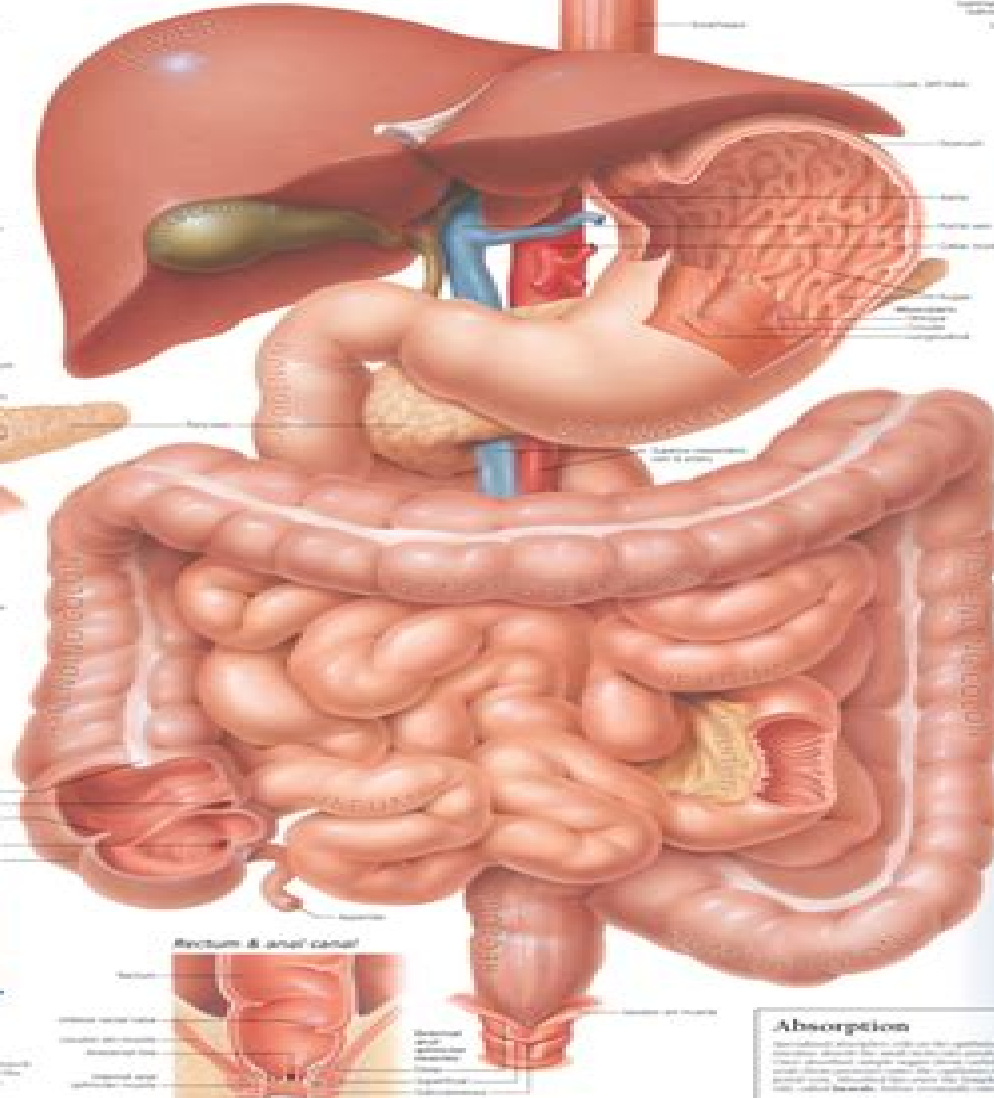
Large intestine

The large intestine consists of the cecum, the appendix, the ascending colon, the transverse colon, the descending colon, and the sigmoid colon. It is responsible for absorbing water and electrolytes from the remaining indigestible food matter, thereby forming feces.



Peristaltic action

Food material is pushed through the digestive system by a series of powerful muscular contractions called peristalsis. These contractions move the material forward and the wave which, when it moves, the material is pushed forward.



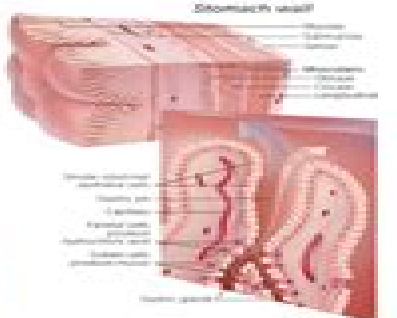
The mouth & salivary glands

Chewing, the mechanical action of the food, begins in the mouth. The tongue mixes the food with the secretions of the salivary glands, which moisten the food and help in swallowing. The salivary glands are located in the mouth and produce saliva, which contains the enzyme amylase that begins the digestion of carbohydrates.



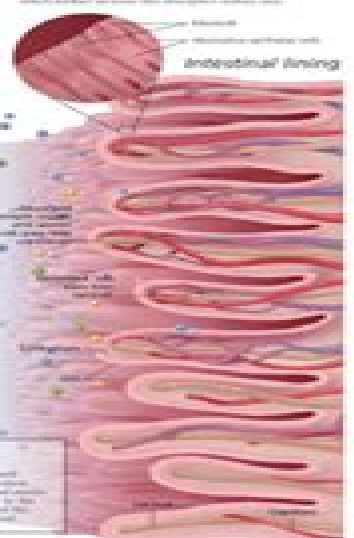
The stomach

The stomach is a large, muscular organ that is responsible for the mechanical and chemical digestion of food. It is located in the upper left part of the abdomen. The stomach wall is composed of several layers, including the mucosa, which contains the gastric glands that secrete gastric juice.



Small intestine

The small intestine is a long, coiled tube that is responsible for the chemical digestion of food. It is located in the central part of the abdomen. The small intestine is divided into three parts: the duodenum, the jejunum, and the ileum.



Absorption

The small intestine is the primary site for the absorption of nutrients. The villi, which are small finger-like projections on the inner surface of the small intestine, increase the surface area for absorption. The nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream and then transported to the rest of the body.
