



The Digestive System

What is the digestive system?

The digestive system, or **gastrointestinal tract**, is a tract of organs that is responsible for digesting and absorbing nutrients from food. Food enters through the mouth, is broken down in the stomach, and then moves through the small intestine, where nutrients are absorbed. The digestive system also includes accessory organs that help in the process, such as the liver, pancreas, and gallbladder.



Liver, pancreas & gallbladder

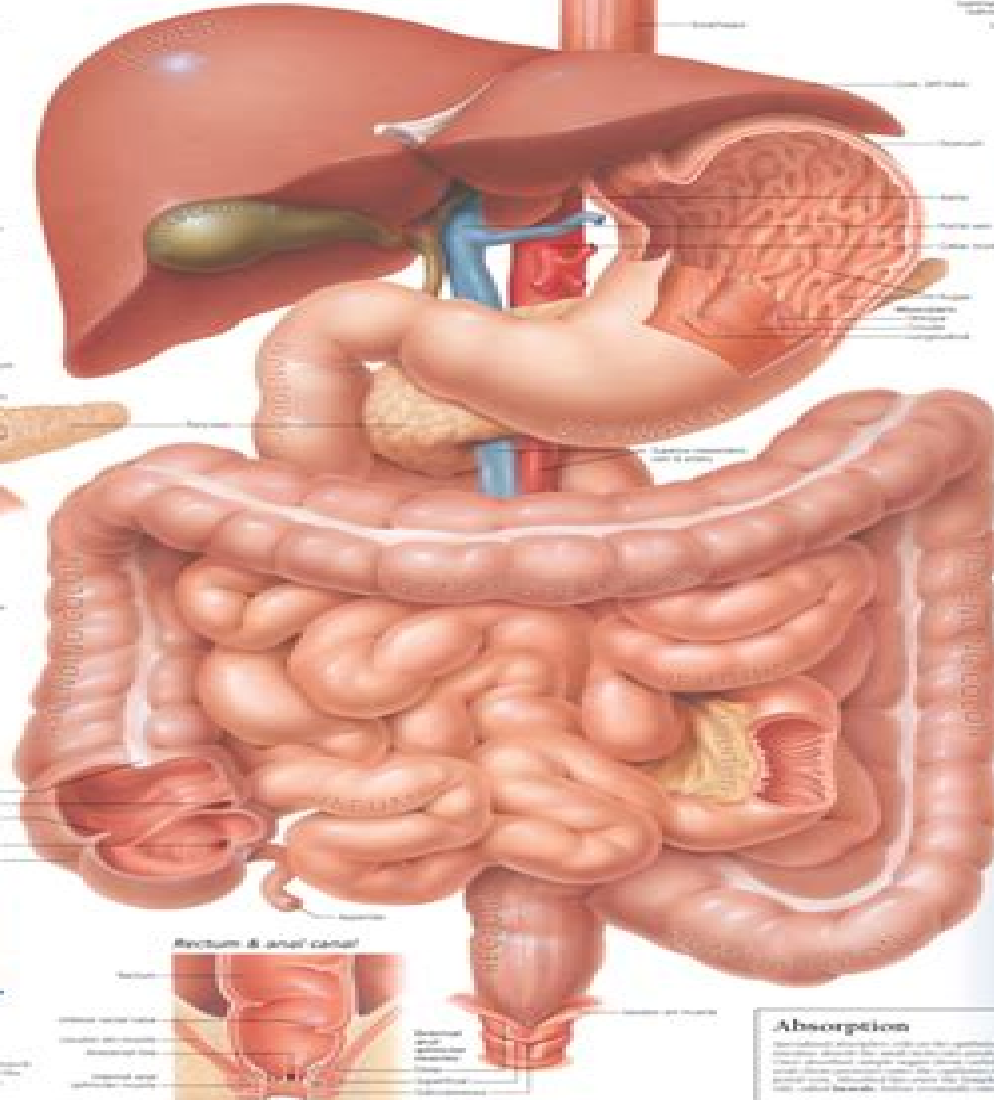
After leaving the stomach, chyme moves into the duodenum, the first part of the small intestine, where it is mixed with bile secreted by the **liver** and pancreatic juice secreted by the **pancreas**. This area is a mixing region on the intestine where the digestive system continues. The **gallbladder** stores bile and releases it into the duodenum.



Large intestine
The large intestine consists of the cecum, the appendix, ascending colon, transverse colon, descending colon, sigmoid colon, and rectum. It is responsible for absorbing water and electrolytes from the remaining indigestible food matter.



Peristaltic action
Food material is pushed through the digestive system by a series of powerful muscular contractions called peristalsis. These contractions move the material forward and the wave which, when it moves, the material is pushed forward.



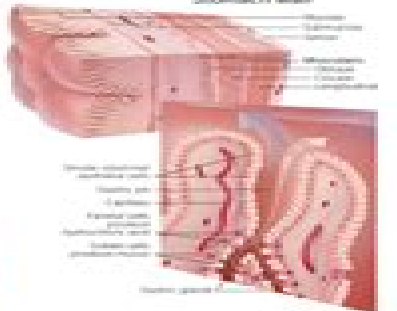
The mouth & salivary glands

Chewing, the mechanical action of the food, is called mastication. Salivary glands secrete saliva, which is mixed with the food in the mouth. The salivary glands are the **parotid**, **sublingual**, and **submandibular** glands. Saliva contains the enzyme **amylase**, which begins the chemical digestion of carbohydrates.



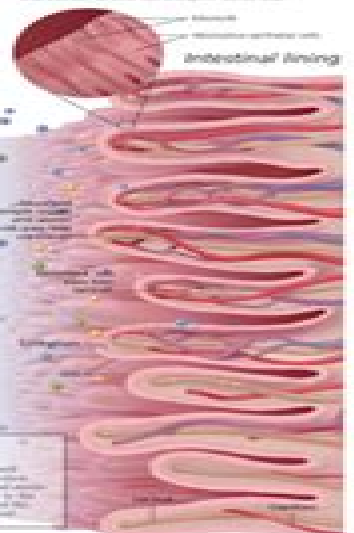
The stomach

The stomach is a large, muscular organ that is responsible for the chemical digestion of food. It is located in the upper left part of the abdomen. The stomach wall is composed of several layers, including the **mucosa**, **submucosa**, **muscularis**, and **serosa**.



Small intestine

The small intestine is a long, coiled tube that is responsible for the chemical digestion of food. It is located in the central part of the abdomen. The small intestine is divided into three parts: the **duodenum**, **jejunum**, and **ileum**.



Absorption

The small intestine is responsible for the absorption of nutrients from the food. The nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream through the walls of the small intestine. The large intestine is responsible for the absorption of water and electrolytes from the remaining indigestible food matter.
