A Social History of the Shona Novel Emmanuel Chiwome,2002 Shona literature now comprises 85% of literature published for schools in Zimbabwe an indication of its significance for the understanding of the philosophical and historical base of the understanding of a language people and nation Chiwome s book argues that the productivity of Shona fiction is inseparable from the dialects of history first colonialism then development and exposes colonialist notions about Shona cultural values and the implications for reading and writing the literature He analyses Shona writers predilections for certain genres of fiction asking why colonialism did not produce historical committed literature and why moralistic and fantastical modes prevail In the latter part of the book he adopts Manichean and Fanonian psychoanalytic approaches to African fictional characters suffering inferiority and collective paranoia and discusses how this relates to the aesthetic qualities of the literatures of decolonisation **Zimbabwe's Cinematic Arts** Katrina Daly Thompson,2013 This timely book reflects on discourses of identity that pervade local talk and texts in Zimbabwe a nation beset by political and economic crisis As she explores questions of culture that play out in broadly accessible local and foreign film and television Katrina Daly Thompson shows how viewers interpret these media and how they impact everyday life language use and thinking about community She offers a unique understanding of how media reflect and contribute to Zimbabwean culture language and ethnicity

Davis,2007 This collection of essays on Zimbabwean literature brings together studies of both Rhodesian and Zimbabwean literature spanning different languages and genres It charts the at times painful process of the evolution of Rhodesian Zimbabwean

identities that was shaped by pre colonial colonial and post colonial realities The hybrid nature of the society emerges as different writers endeavour to make sense of their world Two essays focus on the literature of the white settler The first distils the essence of white settlers alienation from the Africa they purport to civilize revealing the delusional fixations of the racist mindset that permeates the discourse of the white man s burden in imperial narratives The second takes up the theme of alienation found in settler discourse showing how the collapse of the white supremacists dream when southern African countries gained independence left many settlers caught up in a profound identity crisis Four essays are devoted to Ndebele writing They focus on the praise poetry composed for kings Mzilikazi and Lobengula the preponderance of historical themes in Ndebele literature the dilemma that lies at the heart of the modern Ndebele identity and the fossilized views on gender roles found in the works of leading Ndebele novelists both female and male The essays on English language writing chart the predominantly negative view of women found in the fiction of Stanley Nyamfukudza assess the destabilization of masculine identities in post colonial Zimbabwe evaluate the complex vision of life and reality in Charles Mungoshi s short stories as exemplified in the tragic isolation of many of his protagonists and explore Dambudzo Marechera s obsession with isolated threatened individuals in his hitherto generally neglected dramas The development of Shona writing is surveyed in two articles the first traces its development from its origins as a colonial educational tool to the more critical works of the post 1980 independence phase the second turns the spotlight on written drama from 1968 when plays seemed divorced from the everyday realities of people s lives to more recent work which engages with corruption and the perversion of the moral order The volume also includes an illuminating interview with Irene Staunton the former publisher of Baobab Books and now of Weaver Press

The Place of Tears Ranka Primorac, 2006-06-30 THIS IS AN NJR NOT JACKET BLURB DO NOT USE IT THIS RAW FORM This new and original work is the only recent monographic treatment of the Zimbabwean novel and its political implications An earlier one by Veit Wild 1992 has not been updated and other such as that by Zhuwarara 2001 are not easily available outside Zimbabwe The author resided in Zimbabwe for almost a decade and has visited the country regularly in the last five years She has published extensively on Zimbabwean literature and brings to her work a deep contextual richness as well as theoretical sophistication Thoroughly up to date the book examines all the published novels of the recently deceased Yvonne Vera d April 2005 as well as major novels of five other internationally acclaimed Zimbabwean writers including Tsitsi Dangarembga and Chenjerai Hove It does so against a political backdrop which goes right up to the March 2005 parliamentary elections The book provides a modern and original historical account of post independence Zimbabwean writing and its relationship to history and politics The critical investigation focuses on fictional representations of space time which links the book the tragically topical Zimbabwean issue of land Dr Primorac employs a form of literary and cultural theory reminiscent of Bakhtinian analysis but drawn at length from East European theoretical sources She investigates what the novels have to say about the Zimbabwean condition and makes a sophisticated link between ideas

about space time and novelistic ideologies More than that drawing a parallel with the experience of Eastern Europe she shows how the novel itself breaks out of the confines of the quasi Marxist analysis which still holds sway in Zimbabwe As such the Zimbabwean novel is itself a source of hope in that troubled land Ranka Primorac has degrees from the universities of Zagreb Zimbabwe and Nottingham Trent She has taught Africa related courses at several institutions of higher learning in Britain including the University of Cambridge and New York University in London She is interested in non western writing and cultures theoretical approaches to the novel and the narrative production of space time Her co edited volume *Versions of Zimbabwe New Approaches to Literature and Culture* was published in 2005 by Weaver Press in Harare Telling Stories, 2021-11-15 The present volume is a highly comprehensive assessment of the postcolonial short story since the thirty six contributions cover most geographical areas concerned Another important feature is that it deals not only with exclusive practitioners of the genre Mansfield Munro but also with well known novelists Achebe Armah Atwood Carey Rushdie so that stimulating comparisons are suggested between shorter and longer works by the same authors In addition the volume is of interest for the study of aspects of orality dialect dance rhythms circularity and trickster figure for instance and of the more or less conflictual relationships between the individual character or implied author and the community Furthermore the marginalized status of women emerges as another major theme both as regards the past for white women settlers or the present for urbanized characters primarily in Africa and India The reader will also have the rare pleasure of discovering Janice Kulik Keefer's Fox her version of what she calls in her commentary displaced autobiography or creative non fiction Lastly an extensive bibliography on the postcolonial short story opens up further possibilities for research *Studying English Literature in Context* Paul Poplawski, 2022-10-13 From early medieval times to the present this diverse collection of thirty one essays sets literary texts in their historical contexts **Innovation Practices for Digital Transformation in the Global South** José Abdelnour-Nocera, Elisha Ondieki Makori, Jose Antonio Robles-Flores, Constance Bitso, 2022-07-28 This book is a collection of chapters from the IFIP working groups 13.8 and 9.4 The 10 papers included present experiences and research on the topic of digital transformation and innovation practices in the global south The topics span from digital transformation initiatives to novel innovative technological developments practices and applications of marginalised people in the global south Africanfuturism Kimberly Cleveland, 2024-02-27 In the past few decades Western studies of Afrofuturism have grown to encompass examples deriving from multiple sites across the diaspora as well as from the African continent However an increasing number of Africans and Africanists have voiced their concerns about grouping African work under the larger umbrella of Afrofuturism without distinction and have emphasized the need to investigate the differences between African American and African production This book offers an introduction to Africanfuturism a body of African speculative works that is distinguishable from albeit related to US based Afrofuturism Kimberly Cleveland uses Africanfuturism as an intellectual lens to explore works that embody combinations of possibilities challenges and concerns

Texts After Terror Rhiannon Graybill, 2021 It is widely recognized that the Hebrew Bible is filled with rape and sexual violence However feminist approaches to the topic remain dominated by Phyllis Trible s 1984 Texts of Terror which describes feminist criticism as a practice of telling sad stories Pushing beyond Trible Texts after Terror offers a new framework for reading biblical sexual violence one that draws on recent work in feminist queer and affect theory and activism against sexual violence and rape culture In the Hebrew Bible as in the contemporary world sexual violence is frequently fuzzy messy and icky Fuzzy names the ambiguity and confusion that often surround experiences of sexual violence Messy identifies the consequences of rape while also describing messy sex and bodies Icky points out the ways that sexual violence fails to fit into neat patterns of evil perpetrators and innocent victims Building on these concepts Texts after Terror offers a number of new feminist strategies and approaches to sexual violence critiquing the framework of consent offering new models of sexual harm emphasizing the importance of relationships between women even in the context of stories of heterosexual rape reading biblical rape texts with and through contemporary texts written by survivors advocating for unhappy reading that makes unhappiness and open endedness into key feminist sites of possibility Texts after Terror also discusses a wide range of biblical rape stories including Dinah Gen 43 Tamar 2 Sam 13 Lot s daughters Gen 19 Bathsheba 2 Sam 11 Hagar Gen 16 and 21 Daughter Zion Lam 1 and 2 and the Levite s concubine Judg 19
