International Scientific Committee for the Drafting of a General History of Africa, 1990 Volume 2 covers the period beginning at the close of the Neolithic era from around the eighth millennium before our era This period of some nine thousand years has been subdivided into four major geographical zones Chapters 1 to 12 cover the Nile Egypt and Nubia by far the largest part of the book is devoted to the ancient civilization of Egypt because of its pre eminent place in the early history of Africa Chapters 13 to 16 relate to the Ethiopian highlands Chapters 17 to 20 describe the Maghrib and its Sahara hinterland and Chapters 21 to 29 the rest of Africa including some of the Indian Ocean islands The series is co published in Africa with seven publishers in the United States and Canada by the University of California Press and in association with the UNESCO Press *The Unity of African Ancient History* Felix Chami, 2006 In one the first studies to gather data from as many related disciplines as possible linguistics and etymology anthropology and rock art and drawing on new archaeological findings and re readings of historical documents the author traces the contours of ancient cultural and trade links between the various peoples and polities of ancient Africa The aim is to discern patterns of peopling and history of the continent and rediscover unknown cultural systems and dynamics of ancient sub Saharan Africa By demonstrating how Africa people developed culturally exchanged knowledge and migrated the study challenges denials of early African cultural sophistication setting an important agenda for future research directions **Ancient Kingdoms of West Africa** Dierk Lange, 2004 Sub Saharan African history does not feature in the world history of the classical period because it continues to be dominated by an emphasis on local paradigms Using hitherto unexplored sources this study places parts of West and also East Africa on the map for the ancient world It shows in particular that the main clan and state structures of several West African kingdoms are based on the same dualistic pattern as that of the Canaanite Israelite and hence also Phoenician societies Supported by written records oral traditions and cult dramatic performances these similarities suggest the existence of early trans Saharan contacts reaching back to the pre Roman period The Phoenician slave trade appears to have been the single most important factor explaining the transfer of these organizational forms from North Africa to the sub Saharan region where they are particularly prominent in the Hausa and Yoruba societies Similar social institutions were transmitted from the Semitic world to the Horn of Africa as a result of the ancient myrrh and frankincense trade Their subsequent contextualization and local adaptation led to the rise of a number of great kingdoms in West and East Africa Some of these polities grew so powerful that they conquered and controlled the successor states of their former metropolitan suzerains Dealing with regional history as well the volume

presents the development of the West African empires of Ghana Mali and Songhay from the new perspective of ethnogenesis There are numerous original maps charts and photographs to illustrate the text Dierk Lange is Professor of African History at the University of Bayreuth in Germany He presents here the results of more than thirty years of research devoted to the history of Africa and explains his more recent focus on relations with Phoenician North Africa Before his appointment in Bayreuth he studied African and Islamic history as well as anthropology in Paris worked on Arabic texts for four years in Cairo and taught African and Islamic history for five years at the University of Niamey He crossed the Sahara several times and undertook more than fifteen research trips to Nigeria Niger and Chad His publications in three languages include two books numerous articles in learned journals and two contributions to the UNESCO history of Africa He is unique in comparing African cultural forms with those of the ancient Near East

world in 331 BCE he made a pit stop in Egypt that forever changed the course of Egyptian history Although his understanding of ancient Egyptian chronology and religion was minimal Alexander was intrigued by ancient pharaonic culture knowing as the 5th century BCE Greek historian Herodotus once wrote Egypt is the gift of the Nile As a result Alexander endeavored to incorporate the land of the pharaohs into Hellenic Civilization The three primary enemies of the Egyptians were the Libyans who occupied the Western Desert and its oases the so called Asiatics who lived in the Levant and finally the Nubians to Egypt's south Among the three peoples the Nubians were the most Egyptianized and at times were integral to the development of Egyptian history Truly the Nubians were the greatest of all sub Saharan peoples in pre modern times and deserve to be studied in their own right apart from ancient Egyptian history In 1515 a Portuguese missionary explorer by the name of Father Francisco Ivaes entered Ethiopia and took note in the interior of the remnants of a civilization of obviously Christian origin with living adherents conforming to a branch of the faith clearly founded in antiquity Could this be the Kingdom of Prester John Father Ivaes was intrigued but he was wary of too fanciful a construction and he speculated more practically on the legend of King Solomon the Queen of Sheba and other such muses As for the city at the center of the civilization he called it Aquasumo Thus the existence of the Kingdom of Aksum came to the notice of Christian Europe after almost 1 000 years of isolation The Ancient Kingdoms of Africa The History and Legacy of the African Continent's Most Prominent Kingdoms in Antiquity chronicles the tumultuous rise and fall of kingdoms like Egypt Nubia Aksum and more *Ancient African Metallurgy* Michael S.
