Select Committee on Small Business, 1979 **Mark Twain Collection "His Novels, Short Stories, Speeches, and Letters"** Mark Twain, 2024-01-23 This Excellent Collection brings together Mark Twain s longer major books and a fine selection of shorter pieces and Science Fiction Books This Books created and collected in Mark Twain s Most important Works illuminate the life and work of one of the most individual writers of the XX century a man who elevated political writing to an art Samuel Langhorne Clemens November 30 1835 April 21 1910 known by his pen name Mark Twain was an American writer humorist entrepreneur publisher and lecturer He was lauded as the greatest humorist the United States has produced and William Faulkner called him the father of American literature His novels include *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* 1876 and its sequel *the Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* 1884 the latter often called *The Great American Novel* Twain was raised in Hannibal Missouri which later provided the setting for *Tom Sawyer* and *Huckleberry Finn* He served an apprenticeship with a printer and then worked as a typesetter contributing articles to the
