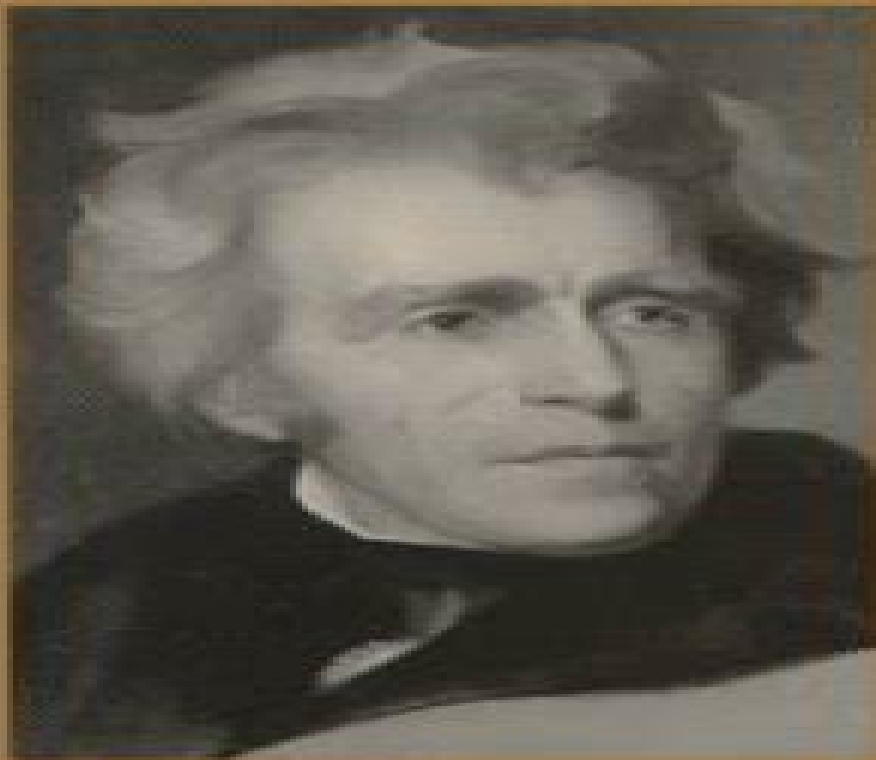

Watson, 1998-03-15 Political rivals Andrew Jackson and Henry Clay shaped American politics during the first half of the nineteenth century Through a clear narrative and primary documents the student is introduced to the political context the language and debates of the day in which the two men arose as spokesmen for their opposing parties with widely differing views of democratic government Andrew Jackson and the Politics of Martial Law Matthew Warshauer, 2006-11 Lucid and well researched The New Yorker In order to win the famous battle of New Orleans Andrew Jackson believed that it was necessary to declare martial law and suspend the writ of habeas corpus In doing so he achieved both a great victory and the notoriety of being the first American general to ever suspend civil liberties in America Andrew Jackson and the Politics of Martial Law tells the history of Jackson s use of martial law and how the controversy surrounding it followed him throughout his life The work engages the age old controversy over if when and who should be able to subvert the Constitution during times of national emergency It also engages the continuing historical controversy over Jackson s political prowess and the importance of the rise of party politics during the early republic As such the book contributes to both the scholarship on Jackson and the legal and constitutional history of the intersection between the military and civilian spheres To fully understand the history of martial law and the subsequent evolution of a theory of emergency powers Matthew Warshauer asserts one must also understand the political history surrounding the discussion of civil liberties and how Jackson s stature as a political figure and his expertise as a politician influenced such debates Warshauer further explains that Abraham Lincoln cited Jackson s use of the military and suspension of civil liberties as justification for similar decisions during the Civil War During both Jackson s and Lincoln s use of martial law critics declared that such an action stood in opposition to both the Constitution and the nation s cherished republican principles of protecting liberty from dangerous power especially that of the military Supporters of martial law insisted that saving the nation became the preeminent cause when the republic was endangered At the heart of such arguments lurked the partisan maneuvering of opposing political parties Andrew Jackson and the Politics of Martial Law is a powerful examination of the history of martial law its first use in the United States and the consequent development of emergency powers for both military commanders and presidents Matthew Warshauer is associate professor of history at Central Connecticut State University He is the author of the forthcoming Andrew Jackson First Men America s Presidents His articles have appeared in Tennessee Historical Quarterly Connecticut History Louisiana History and New York History **Women in the Life of Andrew Jackson** Ludwig M. hostess for most of his presidency and was one of the few women to stand up to Jackson's overbearing nature. She along with Rachel Jackson and Mary Eaton, the wife of Jackson's Secretary of War, was also involved in the Petticoat Affair, a historic scandal that consumed the early Jackson administration. His daughter-in-law Sarah Yorke Jackson and niece Mary Eastin Polk supported Jackson in his retirement and buttressed his political legacy. These six women helped to mold, support, and temper the figure of Andrew Jackson we know today.

This bold groundbreaking study of American political development assesses the presidency of Abraham Lincoln through the lenses of governmental power, economic policy, expansion of executive power, and natural rights to show how Lincoln not only believed in the limitations of presidential power but also dedicated his presidency to restraining the scope and range of it. Though Lincoln's presidency is inextricably linked to the Civil War and he is best known for his defense of the Union and executive wartime leadership, Lincoln believed that Congress should be at the helm of public policy making. Likewise, Lincoln may have embraced limited government in vague terms but he strongly supported effective rule of law and distribution of income and wealth. Instead of relying too heavily on the will of the people and institutional solutions to help prevent tyranny, Jon D. Schaff proposes that American democracy would be better served by a moderate and prudential statesmanship such as Lincoln's, which would help limit democratic excesses. Schaff explains how Lincoln's views on prudence, moderation, natural rights, and economics contain the notion of limits, then views Lincoln's political and presidential leadership through the same lens. He compares Lincoln's views on governmental powers with the defense of unlimited government by twentieth-century progressives and shows how Lincoln's theory of labor anticipated twentieth-century distributist economic thought. Schaff's unique exploration falls squarely between historians who consider Lincoln a protoprogressive and those who say his presidency was a harbinger of industrialized, corporatized America. In analyzing Lincoln's approach, *Abraham Lincoln's Statesmanship and the Limits of Liberal Democracy* rejects the idea he was a revolutionary statesman and instead lifts up Lincoln's own affinity for limited presidential power, making the case for a modest approach to presidential power today based on this understanding of Lincoln's statesmanship. As a counterpoint to the contemporary landscape of bitter, uncivil politics, Schaff points to Lincoln's statesmanship as a model for better ways of engaging in politics in a democracy.
