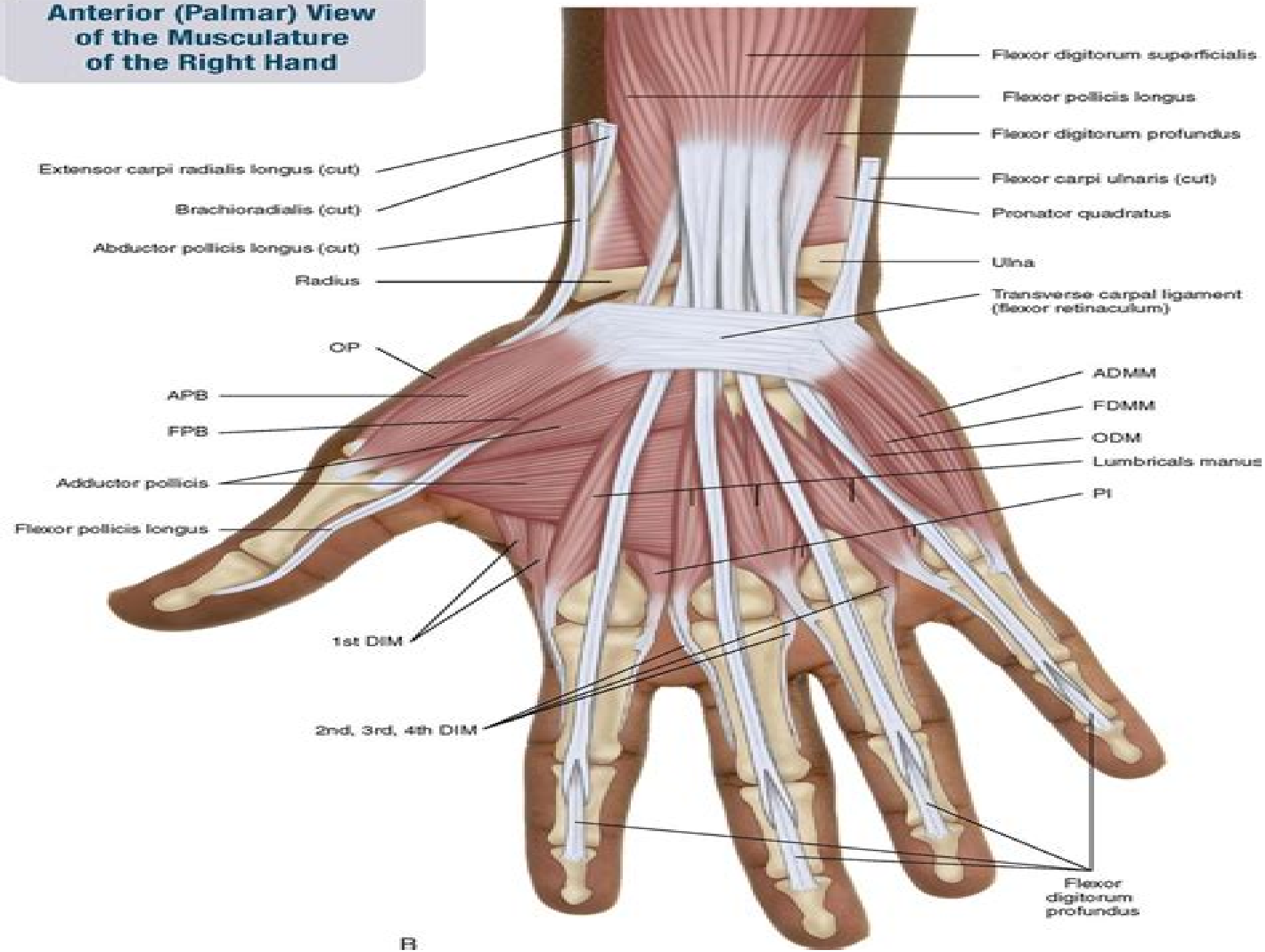


Anterior (Palmar) View of the Musculature of the Right Hand
