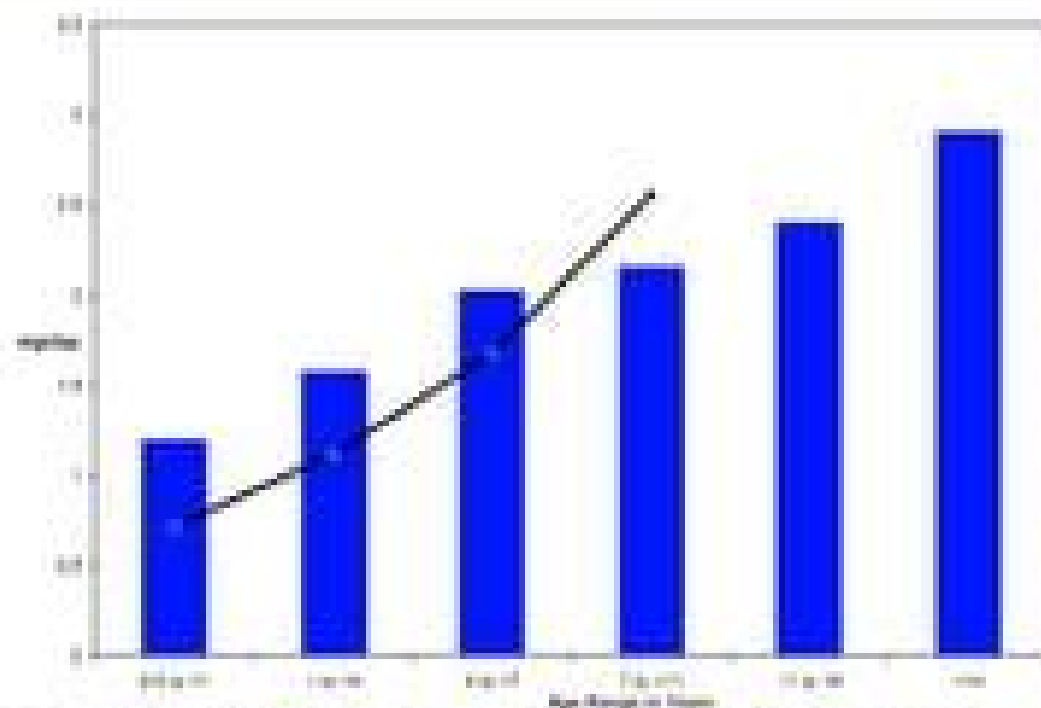
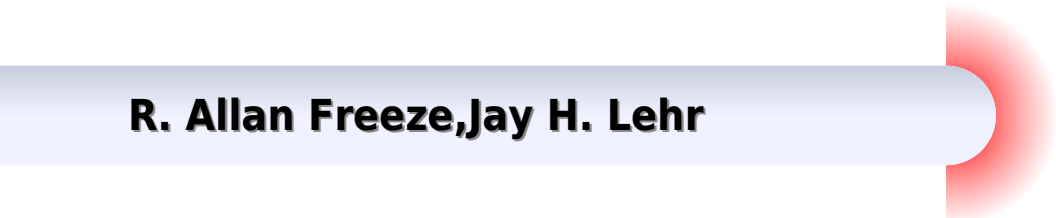


Figure 8-1. Total Daily Fluoride Intake Estimates Relative to the Proposed RfD Using 95th Percentile Drinking Water Intake Data for Consumption Only and the Mean Drinking Water Fluoride Concentration (0.07 mg/L).

The Case against Fluoride Paul Connett, James Beck, Spedding Micklem, 2010-10-07 National Health Information Award At once painstakingly documented and also highly readable *The Case Against Fluoride* brings new research to light it explores the poor science bizarre tactics biased reviews and puzzling motivations of a relatively small number of influential people who continue to push this practice on a largely ill informed public American Academy of Environmental Medicine Newsletter When the U S Public Health Service endorsed water fluoridation in 1950 there was little evidence of its safety Now six decades later and after most countries have rejected the practice more than 70 percent of Americans as well as 200 million people worldwide are drinking fluoridated water The Center for Disease Control and the American Dental Association continue to promote it and even mandatory statewide water fluoridation despite increasing evidence that it is not only unnecessary but potentially hazardous to human health In this timely and important book Dr Paul Connett Dr James Beck and Dr H Spedding Micklem take a new look at the science behind water fluoridation and argue that just because the dental and medical establishments endorse a public health measure doesn't mean it's safe In the case of water fluoridation the chemicals that go into the drinking water that more than 180 million people drink each day are not even pharmaceutical grade but rather a hazardous waste product of the phosphate fertilizer industry It is illegal to dump this waste into the sea or local surface water and yet it is allowed in our drinking water To make matters worse this program receives no oversight from the Food and Drug Administration and the Environmental Protection Agency takes no responsibility for the practice And from an ethical standpoint say the authors water fluoridation is a bad medical practice individuals are being forced to take medication without their informed consent there is no control over the dose and no monitoring of possible side effects Alfred North Whitehead said the scientific method means leaving options open for revision An ancient Roman adage says that whatever touches all must be approved by all These characterizations of science and democracy are the reasons for reading this book Especially if you and your family are drinking administratively mandated fluoridated water Ralph Nader
