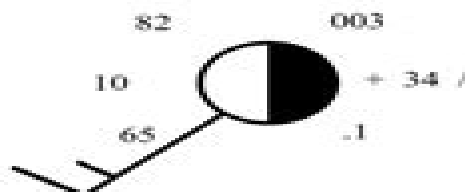
When you watch a weather report, the meteorologist describes the condition of the atmosphere at the present time, and makes a prediction about the future conditions that will exist in the atmosphere in the next 12 to 24 hours, and even for the next 5 days. Meteorologists get the data they need from *synoptic weather maps* - maps that show weather conditions from a number of weather stations around the country.

Individual weather stations report current conditions which are encoded on the map. This quick lab exercise will familiarize you with the information and method of encoding information on weather maps.

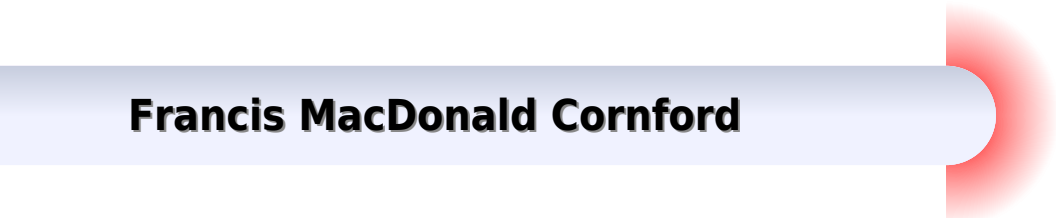
What is the highest pressure (in millibars) labeled on that chart? 1041 mb

The two pressures above are the approximate high and low limits of atmospheric air pressures that are observed at the earth's surface. Meteorologists take advantage of the limited range of observed pressures to encode them on the weather map.

There is need for a new comparison of the two philosophers, one which is limited in scope based on the primary texts and which is systematic and thorough in method. If successful, such a comparison would bring into sharp focus one phase of Aristotle's comments on Plato. Our attempt to meet this need is Aristotle's Criticism of Plato's TIMAEUS.
