She then goes on to talk about how amazing her family was by saying "Of having a family that daily worked with nature to produce the extraordinary". She puts a lot of emphasis on the word "magic" and how being in the country is magical. I can relate with Walker when she says that the country is magical because I too am from the country. Being in the city I don't feel as free as I want to. In the country I am able to do more of what I want. In the country, everything is fresher, I can see the stars, and everyone around me is friendly. I think Walker wants to pass on the traditions that she learned from her family on to her daughter, so she can pass them on to her children.
