Terrestrial Animals

Animals on land

- Lungs to breathe
- Mostly 4 legs
- Well developed sense organs

Behavioral adaptation in tiger - Stripes

- Tiger's stripes help the tiger camouflage when it hunts because the prey might think it was grass or trees.



Animals in desert

Thick skin

- Very little hair
- Flat Feet
- Thick fur for shade and allow heat loss.

Behavioral Adaptation

- Camels have special organs to store water because of less water availability in deserts.

Animals in Cold Areas

- Thick Skin
- Fur to protect from cold
- Strong sense of smell

Behavioral Adaptation in Penguin

- Penguin have thick layer of fat under their skin called Blubber it helps keep their body warm and is used as food in winter.

- Have gills to breathe
- Fins to help in swimming

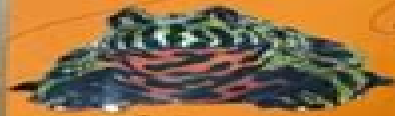
Behavioral adaptation in duck

Frog

Behavioral adaptation in Frog

- Powerful hind legs and feet allow frog to jump long distances.

Amphibians

- Lives both on land and water
- Breathe through lungs when in land and moist skin when in water.



Arboreal Animals

- Sharp claws
- Stout chest

Behavioral Adaptation of Squirrel

- Squirrels are able to rotate their hind feet which allows them to descend down a tree.

ADAPTATION IN BEHAVIOUR

- * **Hibernation** - Animals eat a lot of food in summers and store extra food in the body as fat. During winter they sleep in caves or underground.

- * **Aestivation** - Crocodiles sleep in summer for a long time.

- * **Migration** - During winter many birds go to warmer places and migrate.
