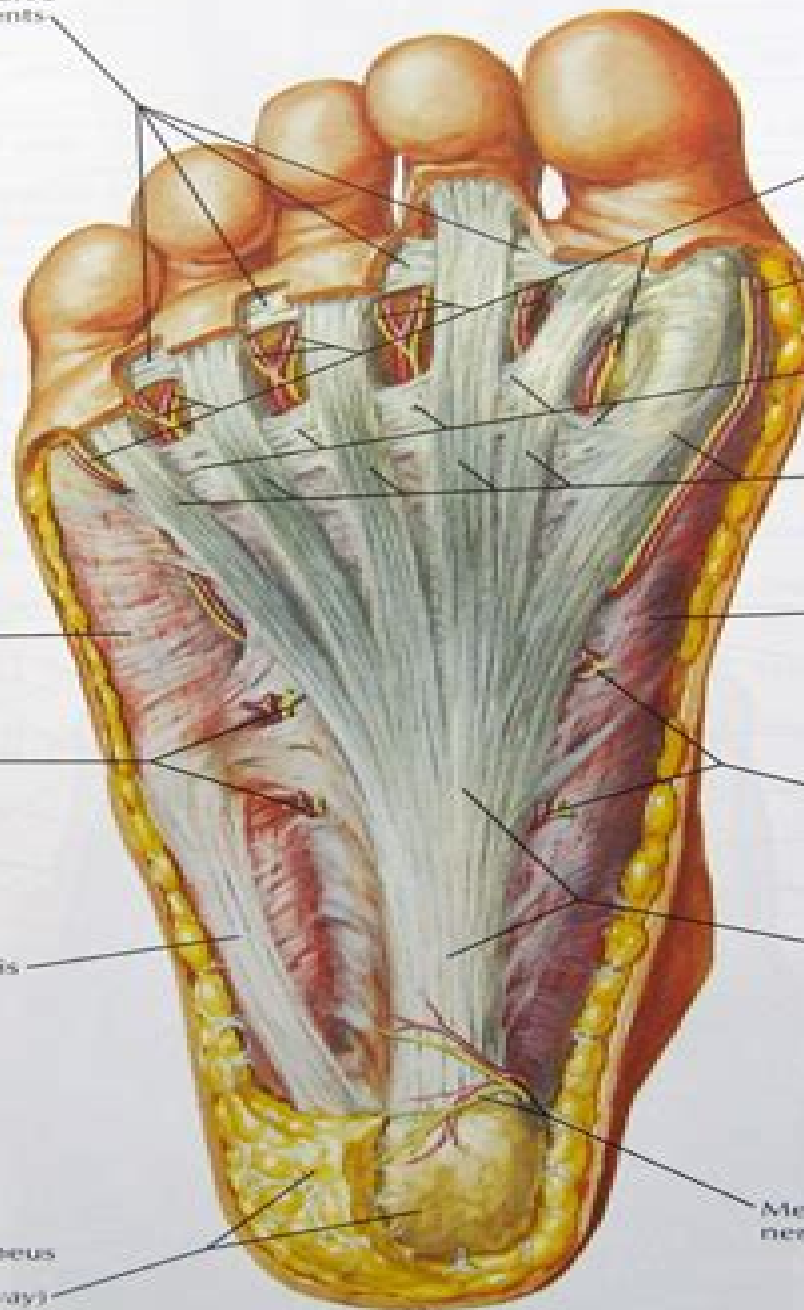

More than 250 vivid anatomical illustrations add clarity to the content. Phonetic spellings are provided immediately following the names of many muscles since they may be difficult to pronounce for students new to the study of anatomy. Pause to Check for Understanding boxes provide students with an opportunity to reflect on important concepts and to consider what they have learned from the major sections within each chapter.
