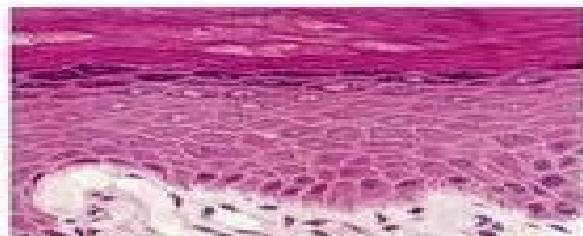

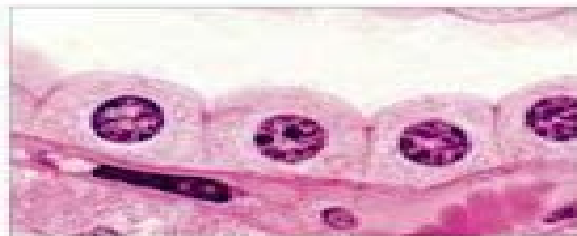
STRATIFIED SQUAMOUS (multilaminar) This tissue is composed of several cell layers. At the basal layer there are cuboidal or columnar cells, and transitional or flattened squamous cells as they approach the surface. This tissue lines the ventricles of the heart, esophagus, and vagina. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)

Epithelial tissue is composed of sheets of tightly packed cells. They can be simple, stratified, cuboidal or columnar. They are composed of the outer surface cells and inside of the body cavity. The skin, the inner lining of the digestive and respiratory tracts, the lining of the ventral body cavity (peritoneum) and the respiratory tract (trachea) are all composed of epithelial tissue. They also form the glands, ducts and vessels of the body.

EPITHELIAL TISSUE



STRATIFIED SQUAMOUS (multilaminar) This tissue is composed of several cell layers. At the basal layer there are cuboidal or columnar cells, and transitional or flattened squamous cells as they approach the surface. This tissue lines the esophagus, stomach, and vagina. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



SIMPLE CUBOIDAL Single layer of cube-shaped cells with central spherical nuclei. Found in kidney tubules, ducts of glands and surface of ovary. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



STRATIFIED CUBOIDAL This tissue is usually composed of two layers of cuboidal cells. It is found in the ducts of sweat, milk, and mammary glands. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



SIMPLE COLUMNAR Single layer of columnar-shaped cells. These cells are found in the lining of the digestive tract and in the lining of the respiratory tract. They also form the glands, ducts and vessels of the body. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



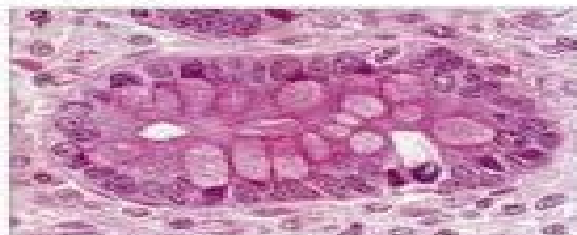
STRATIFIED COLUMNAR This tissue is composed of several layers of columnar cells and a basal layer of cuboidal cells. Found in the lining of the respiratory tract and in the lining of the digestive tract. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



PSEUDOSTRATIFIED This tissue appears stratified but is actually a single layer of cells with short cells. All cells reach the basement membrane of the tissue. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



TRANSITIONAL This tissue has the appearance of stratified squamous tissue, but the cells can change shape. It is found in the lining of the urinary bladder and ureters. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



GLANDULAR (secretory) This tissue which is produced by the cells of the body. It is found in the lining of the digestive tract and in the lining of the respiratory tract. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)



GLANDULAR (secretory) This tissue produces and secretes substances into the body cavity or into the blood. It is found in the lining of the digestive tract and in the lining of the respiratory tract. (Hanson, microanatomy 12419)
