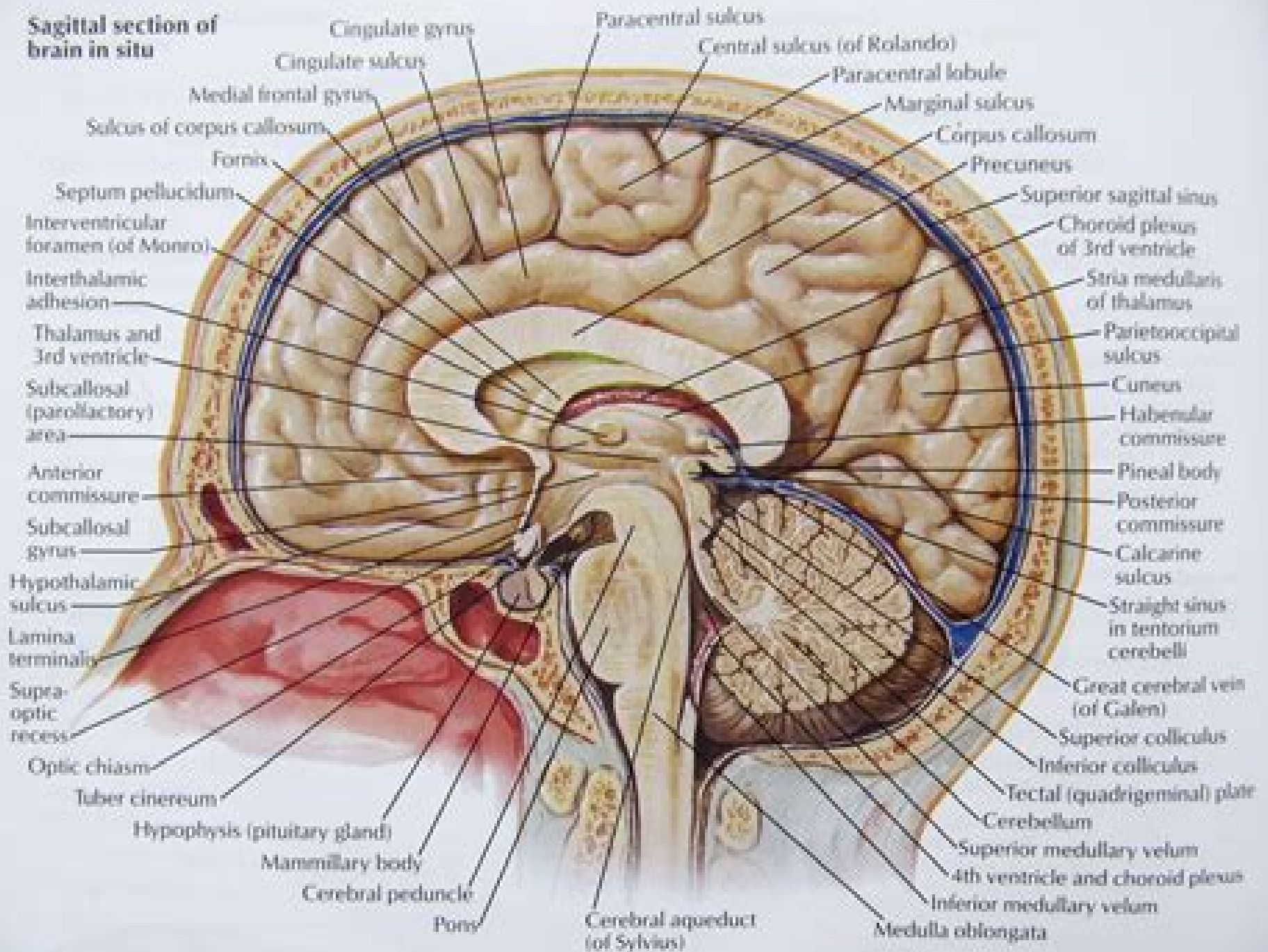


Sagittal section of brain in situ
