Representing Multiculturalism in Comics and Graphic Novels Carolene Ayaka, Ian Hague, 2014-11-20

Multiculturalism and its representation has long presented challenges for the medium of comics This book presents a wide ranging survey of the ways in which comics have dealt with the diversity of creators and characters and the lack of visibility for characters who don't conform to particular cultural stereotypes Contributors engage with ethnicity and other cultural forms from Israel Romania North America South Africa Germany Spain U S Latino and Canada and consider the ways in which comics are able to represent multiculturalism through a focus on the formal elements of the medium Discussion themes include education countercultures monstrosity the quotidian the notion of the other anthropomorphism and colonialism Taking a truly international perspective the book brings into dialogue a broad range of comics traditions *The Anarchist Cookbook* Keith McHenry, Chaz Bufe, Hedges Chris, 2015-09-29 From the cofounder of Food Not Bombs an action oriented guide to anarchism social change and vegan cooking Unlike the original *Anarchist Cookbook* which contained instructions for the manufacture of explosives this version is both a cookbook in the literal sense and also a cookbook of

recipes for social and political change The coffee table sized book is divided into three sections a theoretical section explaining what anarchism is and what it isn't information on organizational principles and tactics for social and political change and finally numerous tasty vegan recipes from one of the cofounders of the international Food Not Bombs movement

Wildcat Anarchist Comics Donald Room, 2016-08-15 Wildcat Anarchist Comics collects the drawings of Donald Room mostly but by no means entirely from the long running Wildcat cartoon series that has been published in Freedom newspaper since 1980 Room does not just purvey jokes but makes the drawings comical in themselves getting the humour in the line provoking laughter even in those who do not read the captions or speech balloons The chief characters in the strip are the Revolting Pussycat a short fused anarchist who is furious and shouty and the Free Range Egghead an intellectual who would like anarchism to be respectable but sometimes appears foolish Governments bosses and authoritarians are presented as buffoons and quite often so are anarchists This thoughtful and delightful collection includes strips from The Skeptic and many more all beautifully colored for the first time by Jayne Clementson The book also includes a lively autobiographical introduction that discusses Room's role in the 1963 Challenor case in which a corrupt police officer planted a weapon on Room at a demonstration ultimately resulting in Room's acquittal

Anarchy in the Big Easy Max Cafard, 2025-04-15 Anarchy in the Big Easy is an anarchist graphic history of the quest for freedom in radical and revolutionary New Orleans The story begins with the anarchic forces of nature creating the land and the cooperative indigenous communities that thrived before the European conquest Next we see the revolt against domination through the Enslaved Peoples Uprising of 1811 the rise of maroon communities the work of figures such as anarchist geographer Elis e Reclus and utopian revolutionary Joseph D jacque and the moving history of labor militancy exemplified by the First International the General Strike of 1892 and the rise of the Industrial Workers of the World The anarchic aspects of jazz are explored including its birthplace the famous red light district of Storyville Other episodes recount the history of the Black Panthers including the legendary shootout in the Desire Project and the important role anarchists played in the grassroots recovery after Hurricane Katrina The often subversive People's Carnival is depicted from the history of the Mardi Gras Indians through today's anarchist marching Krewes The book concludes with the recent struggle to take down the confederate monuments and the growth of a decentralized autonomous mutual aid movement These stories are recounted by surregionalist writer Max Cafard and brought vividly to life through the striking images of comix artist Vulpes

Golo,2024-11-05 His life belonged to him only His books belonged to the public B Traven Portrait of a Famous Unknown is a graphic biography that tells the larger than life story of the German revolutionary actor and writer known as B Traven 1882 1969 Despite his commercial success as a best selling writer Traven managed to keep his identity a secret during his lifetime It is now generally accepted that Traven was in fact Ret Marut another pseudonym a German stage actor and editor of an anarchist newspaper in Germany called Der Ziegelbrenner The Brickburner As Marut he was a major participant in the short lived Bavarian Council Republic of 1919 20 Barely escaping execution he fled Germany and lived incognito for the remainder of his life His entire literary work a great commercial success in its day combines lively and often humorous storytelling with radical critique of capitalism and nationalism His best known work The Treasure of the Sierra Madre from 1927 was adapted for film in 1948 by John Huston Golo s account of Traven s life rendered with stunning artwork begins and ends with his ashes being dropped from a plane over the Lacandon jungle in Chiapas Mexico just a quarter century before the explosive

uprising of the Zapatistas seemed to echo his deepest wishes

The Day the Klan Came to Town Bill

Campbell, 2021-08-17 The year is 1923 The Ku Klux Klan is at the height of its power in the US as membership swells into the millions and they expand beyond their original southern borders As they grow so do their targets As they continue their campaigns of terror against African Americans their list now includes Catholics and Jews southern and eastern Europeans all in the name of white supremacy But they are no longer considered a terrorist organization By adding the messages of moral decency family values and temperance the Klan has slapped on a thin veneer of respectability and has become a civic organization attracting ordinary citizens law enforcement and politicians to their particular brand of white Anglo Saxon and Protestant Americanism Pennsylvania enthusiastically joined that wave That was when the Grand Dragon of Pennsylvania decided to display the Klan's newfound power in a show of force He chose a small town outside of Pittsburgh named after Andrew Carnegie a small unassuming borough full of Catholics and Jews the perfect place to teach these immigrants a lesson Some thirty thousand members of the Klan gathered from as far as Kentucky for Carnegie Day After initiating new members they armed themselves with torches and guns to descend upon the town to show them exactly what Americanism was all about The Day the Klan Came to Town is a fictionalized retelling of the riot focusing on a Sicilian immigrant Primo Salerno He is not a leader he's a man with a troubled past He was pulled from the sulfur mines of Sicily as a teen to fight in the First World War Afterward he became the focus of a local fascist and was forced to emigrate to the United States He doesn't want to fight but feels that he may have no choice The entire town needs him and indeed everybody to make a stand
