Room,2016-08-15 *Wildcat Anarchist Comics* collects the drawings of Donald Room mostly but by no means entirely from the long running Wildcat cartoon series that has been published in Freedom newspaper since 1980 Room does not just purvey jokes but makes the drawings comical in themselves getting the humour in the line provoking laughter even in those who do not read the captions or speech balloons The chief characters in the strip are the Revolting Pussycat a short fused anarchist who is furious and shouty and the Free Range Egghead an intellectual who would like anarchism to be respectable but sometimes appears foolish Governments bosses and authoritarians are presented as buffoons and quite often so are anarchists This thoughtful and delightful collection includes strips from *The Skeptic* and many more all beautifully colored for the first time by Jayne Clementson The book also includes a lively autobiographical introduction that discusses Room's role in the 1963 Challenor case in which a corrupt police officer planted a weapon on Room at a demonstration ultimately resulting in Room's acquittal **Anarchy in the Big Easy** Max Cafard,2025-04-15

In the 1950s, comics meant POW, BAM, superheroes, family-friendly gags, and Sunday funnies, but in the 1960s, inspired by these strips and the satire of MAD magazine, a new generation of creators set out to subvert the medium and with it American culture. Their comix spelled that way to distinguish the work from their dime-store contemporaries: presented tales of taboo, sex, casual drug use, and a transgressive view of society. Embraced by hippies and legions of future creatives, this subgenre of comic books and strips often ran afoul of the law, but that would not stop them from casting cultural ripples for decades to come, eventually moving the entire comics form beyond the gutter and into fine art galleries. Brian Doherty weaves together the stories of R. Crumb, Art Spiegelman, Trina Robbins, Spain Rodriguez, Harvey Pekar, and Howard Cruse among many others, detailing the complete narrative history of this movement. Through dozens of new interviews and archival research, he chronicles the scenes that sprang up around the country in the 1960s and 70s, beginning with the artists' origin stories and following them through success and strife, and concluding with an examination of these creators' legacies. *Dirty Pictures* is the essential exploration of a truly American art form that recontextualized the way people thought about war, race, sex, gender, and expression.

Outrage Clément Duval, 2012-08-24 Theft exists only through the exploitation of man by man when Society refuses you the right to exist, you must take it. The policeman arrested me in the name of the Law. I struck him in the name of Liberty.
