

GUIDE TO THE FUNGI

This guide to the different kinds of fungi in this book is not a key, but may help you to identify some of the more common and widespread species—or at least discover to which group they may belong. Less than one percent of known fungal species are featured in this volume, so be aware that the particular fungus that you are looking for may not be here.

AGARICS

Fleshy fruitbodies; cap with or without stem; gills underneath cap (rarely pores). Species with gilled fruitbodies are in this section, but note that some chanterelles (pp. 476–83) have gill-like ridges or veins and some bracket fungi (pp. 364–420) have tough or woody, gill-like undersurfaces.
