

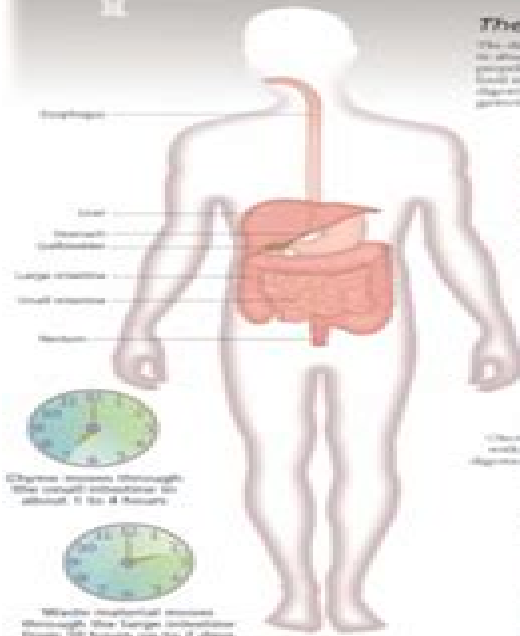

The Digestive Process

The digestive system

The digestive system, or gastrointestinal tract, is essentially a muscular tube in which food is broken down by the action of enzymes and chemical action. Food enters the mouth, is chewed, and is propelled through a series of different accessory and absorptive components. Within these components, food is digested (broken down) by digestive enzymes. Two components must remain in the stomach. The digestive system also stores undigested components until they are ready to be expelled at the end of the gastrointestinal tract.



Ingestion



Food is chewed and swallowed in about 1 minute.

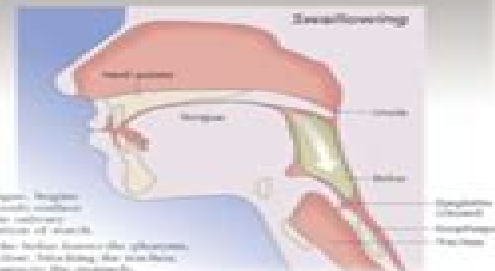


Food moves through the stomach in 2 to 4 hours.

When in the stomach, food is chewed and mixed with hydrochloric acid and enzymes to begin the digestion of proteins. The stomach also churns or even abrades or partially digests food, for processing later by the small intestine.

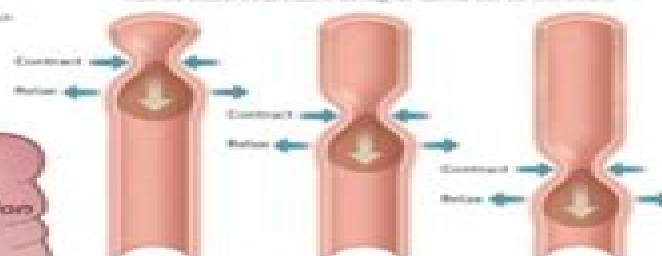
Chewing & swallowing

Chewing, the mechanical action of the mouth and tongue, begins the breakdown of solid food. This greatly increases food's surface area and exposes the food to the action of the salivary glands. Saliva contains the food and begins the digestion of starch. The mixture of food and saliva is called a *bolus*. In the bolus, the pharynx, the esophagus, a flap-like valve, and the vocal cord contract, forcing the bolus forward, where it moves down through the esophagus to the stomach.



Peristaltic action

Material is moved through the digestive system by a series of muscle contractions called peristalsis. The muscle is relaxed in the material contents, while the muscle ahead contracts, forcing the material into the next section.



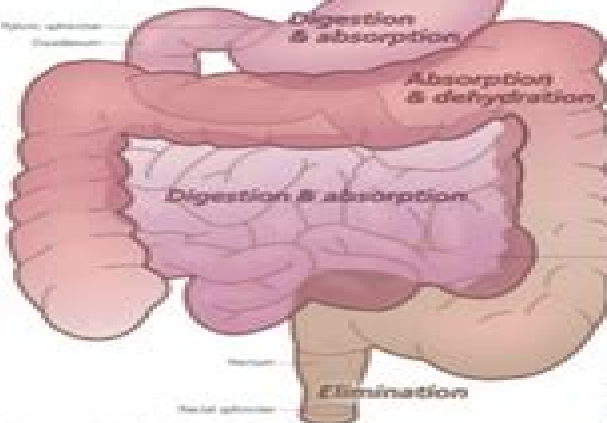
In the peristaltic action, material moves through the large intestine, where water and electrolytes are absorbed (reabsorbed). This reabsorption moves the material forward and regular contractions.

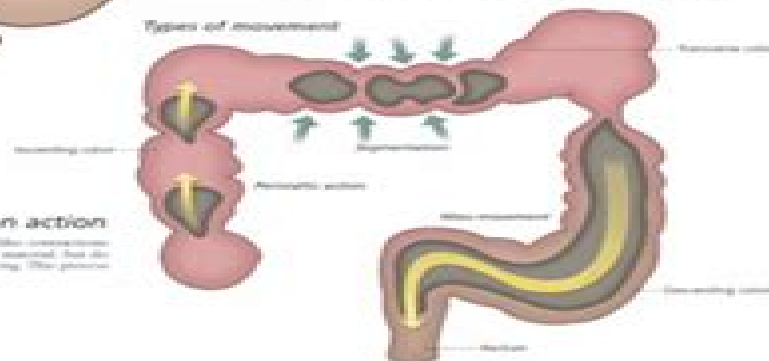

Colonic movement

Movement through the large intestine is accomplished through the contractions of the longitudinal and circular muscles. Types of movement include peristaltic action, segmental action, and mass movement. Movement of food through the large intestine is slower than through the small intestine, allowing for reabsorption of water.

Types of movement

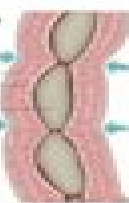


Segmentation action

In regular intervals, ring-like contractions (chase) and relax the water material, thus the water is called segmentation.

Large intestine

Longitudinal muscle, Circular muscle, Peristaltic action.



Muscle contractions begin to break up the material.



Continuing muscle contractions produce further mixing.



The waste material has been mixed, but not moved.
