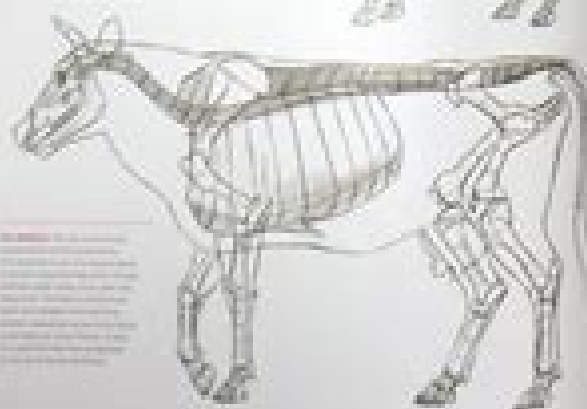
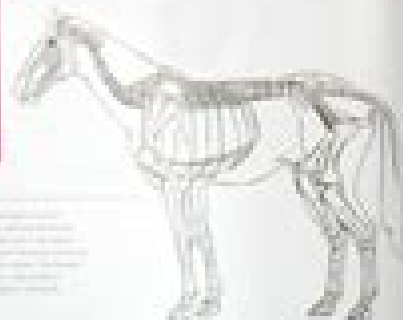


THE HORSE'S SKIN is the largest organ of the body. It is composed of the epidermis, the dermis, and the hypodermis. The epidermis is the outermost layer, the dermis is the middle layer, and the hypodermis is the innermost layer. The skin is covered with hair, which is made of keratin. The skin also contains sweat glands, sebaceous glands, and blood vessels.

THE HORSE'S MUSCLES are the organs that contract to produce movement. They are composed of muscle fibers, which are made of actin and myosin. The muscles are innervated by the nervous system, which sends signals to the muscles to contract.



THE HORSE'S BONES are the rigid structures that support the body and protect the internal organs. They are composed of calcium and phosphorus. The bones are connected by joints, which allow for movement. The skeleton is divided into the axial skeleton (skull, spine, and ribs) and the appendicular skeleton (arms and legs).



THE HORSE'S JOINTS are the points where two or more bones meet. They are classified into three types: fibrous joints, cartilaginous joints, and synovial joints. Synovial joints are the most common type and allow for the greatest range of motion.



THE HORSE'S LIGAMENTS are the structures that connect bones to each other. They are made of dense, fibrous tissue and help to stabilize the joints. There are many ligaments in the horse's body, including the collateral ligaments, cruciate ligaments, and suspensory ligaments.
