- Visual pathway:** The path of light from the eye to the brain.
- Visual cortex:** The part of the brain that processes visual information.
- Visual perception:** The process of interpreting visual information.
- Visual memory:** The ability to store and recall visual information.
- Visual attention:** The ability to focus on a specific visual stimulus.
