Indeed, the authors suggest that all of the variety seen outside of Africa seems to have both accumulated and started reintegrating within only the last 50 000 or 60 000 years—the blink of an eye from an evolutionary perspective. The overarching message of *Race: Debunking a Scientific Myth* is that scientifically speaking, there is nothing special about racial variation within the human species. These distinctions result from the working of entirely mundane evolutionary processes such as those encountered in other organisms.
