Youth also possess this uncanny habit of being reckless and irresponsible in their actions. Most of their doings are mandated by the drive to be always happy and free. However, their irresponsible merriment often constitutes with thoughtless means of actions leading to unfavorable results.

Love, as depicted in the story, can be either the most powerful motivation for growth or the most destructive force in your life. Youth are swayed with the onset of the enormous intensity of love. Dodong, in all his youthful vigor, failed to grasp the real essence of all its deeper worth. He only skims its shallow impression. Dodong is Villa's representation of a youth who had been waylaid by love. He had also served as a caution to those youth that love must not overpower wit and defy reasons. Life in Footnote to Youth is considered as an offspring of what comes after Youth and Love as stated in the lines, "Youth must triumph... now. Love must triumph... now. Afterwards... it will be life." It is Life that decides if Youth and Love had indeed succeeded. It is the outcome of Youth and Life that dictates the way of life. Villa had repeatedly emphasized the interconnection of Youth, Love and Life as a cyclical occurrence. They are the
