**100 Creative Drawing Ideas** Anna Held Audette, 2004 What art student doesn't groan at the hackneyed problems too often assigned in art classes such as a still life and chianti bottles old chairs and large cloths draped over the whole scene Here in the first book ever of its kind is a collection of interesting and original ideas for drawing projects contributed by art instructors from all over the United States and a few from Canada Great Britain and Australia who have invented successful alternatives to humdrum exercises The accompanying illustrations demonstrate ways in which their students have addressed the assignments and are included to help the reader visualize what might result from the written description This book will be a welcome resource for art teachers and students in high school college graduate programs and art schools as well as artists undertaking independent study Among the 100 drawing ideas are Drawing with a piece of charcoal held between the toes to explore how limitations often bring out great creativity Adopting a mouse's eye view of a still life an unusual twist on perspective drawing Making a self portrait that does not show the head but tells something significant about the artist through the depiction of other parts of the body an original way of investigating Who am I Constructing a figure from assembled objects and then drawing it for those times when a live human model is unavailable Creating a personal visual representation of the blues musical genre to discover how one art form engenders another
