# STRUCTURE AND ARRANGEMENT OF CHROMOSOMES IN A NORMAL HUMAN KARYOTYPE

- Each chromosome comorises two chromatids
- held together by a centromere
- There are 23 pairs 1/46 chromosomes in
- human somatic cells //body cells
- which are arranged into homologous pairs√
- that are similar in length
- carry genes for the same characteristics√
