targeting tailored information delivery citizen science credit scoring and user feedback collection all with the over arching aim to improve data quality and access for those studying the sustainable development of smallholder farming systems The goal of this Research Topic is to better define that niche the ecosystem of tools and current practices and to explore how such approaches can provide the underpinning knowledge required for the transformation of smallholder farming systems One example of an agile data oriented research tool is the Rural Household Multi Indicator Survey RHoMIS It is a modular digital system for building household surveys addressing the common topics in smallholder development It was purposefully designed to give a broad overview of the farm system whist keeping survey duration to a minimum to be user friendly in implementation and to be sufficiently flexible to function in a broad variety of locations and projects Since 2015 it has been used by 30 organizations in 32 countries to interview over 34 000 households.
