Nazis in the New World Aaron Gillette, 2025-05-27 The incredible story of Nazi German exchange students in the United States during WWII In the 1930s international exchange students in the United States celebrated their Christmas breaks in Florida enthusiastically engaged in college aged antics rowdy parties and the defiance of authorities In between such mayhem they admired the beauty of America quietly discussed their impressions of their host country and agonized over their future which would now be reshaped by their study abroad experiences These were not typical international college students however These students were Nazis In *Nazis in the New World* Aaron Gillette reveals the unknown history of Nazi German exchange students sent to America in the 1930s After receiving the Gestapo s stamp of approval they were instructed to use their charm and charisma to promote the Third Reich Some also served Hitler as covert operatives against the United States In many cases the Nazi government came to regret sending its students across the ocean Gillette argues that Nazism was an abject failure in the United States that antisemitism was on the decline that German espionage in America was a disaster for the Reich and that FDR and J Edgar Hoover brilliantly manipulated Nazi blunders to propel America into the war against Hitler and to empower the FBI Meanwhile numerous German exchange students in the United States were transformed from Nazis into fiercely patriotic Americans

In doing so, they have enhanced their prospects for political sovereignty within Canada. As such, they now increasingly occupy what Schouls refers to metaphorically as the spaces in between. The book asserts that occupation of these jurisdictional spaces in between not only goes some distance in meeting the requirements of Indigenous rights but also contributes to Indigenous community autonomy and well-being, enhancing prospects for reconciliation between Indigenous peoples and the Canadian state.

and lead their communities to shape for them a national future

Politics and Foreign Policy in the Age of George I,

1714-1727 Professor Jeremy Black, 2014-04-28 Through its focus on the relationship between foreign and domestic politics this book provides a new perspective on the often fractious and tangled events of George I's reign 1714-27 This was a period of transition for Britain as royal authority gave way to cabinet government and as the country began to exercise increased influence upon the world stage It was a reign that witnessed the trauma of the 1715 Jacobite Rebellion saw Britain fighting Spain as part of the Quadruple Alliance and in which Britain confronted the rise of Russia under Peter the Great There has been relatively little new detailed work on this subject since Hatton's biography of George I appeared in 1978 and that book while impressive devoted relatively little attention to the domestic political dimension of foreign policy In contrast Black links diplomacy to domestic politics to show that foreign policy was a key aspect of government as well as the leading battleground both for domestic politics and for ministerial rivalries As a result he demonstrates how party identities in foreign policy were not marginal to either policy or party but instead central to both The research is based upon a wealth of both British and foreign archive material including State Papers Domestic Scotland Ireland and Regencies as well as Foreign Extensive use is also made of parliamentary and ministerial papers as well as the private papers of numerous diplomats Foreign archives consulted include papers from Hanover Osnabrück Darmstadt Marburg Munich Paris The Hague Vienna and Turin By drawing upon such a wide ranging array of sources this book offers a rich and nuanced view of politics and foreign policy under George I

The Conservative Case for Class Actions Brian T. Fitzpatrick, 2019-11-01 Since the 1960s the class action lawsuit has been a powerful tool for holding businesses accountable Yet years of attacks by corporate America and unfavorable rulings by the Supreme Court have left its future uncertain In this book Brian T Fitzpatrick makes the case for the importance of class action litigation from a surprising political perspective an unabashedly conservative point of view Conservatives have opposed class actions in recent years but Fitzpatrick argues that they should see such litigation not as a danger to the economy but as a form of private enforcement of the law He starts from the premise that all of us conservatives and libertarians included believe that markets need at least some rules to thrive from laws that enforce contracts to laws that prevent companies from committing fraud He also reminds us that conservatives consider the private sector to be superior to the government in most areas And the relatively little discussed intersection of those two beliefs is where the benefits of class action lawsuits become clear when corporations commit misdeeds class action lawsuits enlist the private sector to intervene resulting in a smaller role for the government lower taxes and ultimately more effective solutions Offering a novel argument that will surprise partisans on all sides *The Conservative Case for Class Actions* is sure to breathe new life into this long running debate

The Closing of the Liberal Mind Kim R. Holmes, 2017-12-12 A former U S Assistant Secretary of State and currently Acting Senior Vice President for Research at The Heritage Foundation Kim R Holmes surveys the state of liberalism in America today and finds that it is becoming its opposite illiberalism abandoning the precepts of open

mindedness and respect for individual rights liberties and the rule of law upon which the country was founded and becoming instead an intolerant rigidly dogmatic ideology that abhors dissent and stifles free speech Tracing the new illiberalism historically to the radical Enlightenment a movement that rejected the classic liberal ideas of the moderate Enlightenment that were prominent in the American Founding Holmes argues that today's liberalism has forsaken its American roots incorporating instead the authoritarian anti clerical and anti capitalist prejudices of the radical and largely European Left The result is a closing of the American liberal mind Where once freedom of speech and expression were sacrosanct today liberalism employs speech codes trigger warnings boycotts and shaming rituals to stifle freedom of thought expression and action It is no longer appropriate to call it liberalism at all but illiberalism a set of ideas in politics government and popular culture that increasingly reflects authoritarian and even anti democratic values and which is devising new strategies of exclusiveness to eliminate certain ideas and people from the political process Although illiberalism has always been a temptation for American liberals lurking in the radical fringes of the Left it is today the dominant ideology of progressive liberal circles This makes it a new danger not only to the once venerable tradition of liberalism but to the American nation itself which needs a viable liberal tradition that pursues social and economic equality while respecting individual liberties
