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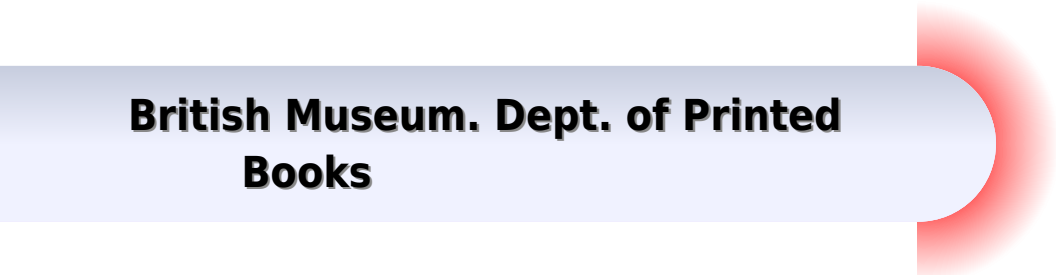

welfare to work agenda of the Giuliani administration in New York City on child care and the resistance to policies that deepened race class and gender inequities
