RGC sold the Renison Bell Mine to Murchison United NL, a Brisbane-based Australian company, in August 1998. Murchison United operated the Renison Bell Mine during the period of lowest tin prices in history. In July 2003 Murchison United went into administration and the mine production ceased.

April 2004 saw the purchase of Renison Bell by Bluestone Tin Limited who operated the mine and mill, under continuing low tin prices, until placing the operation into 'care and maintenance' in September 2005. Bluestone Tin Limited, now Metals X Limited, recommissioned the mill and mine in 2008 with the first tin produced in August 2008. Mining recommenced in 2008/2009, with the company also operating an open-cut mine at Mt Bischoff to provide one feed for the Renison tin concentrator. In 2009/2010 a total of 392,000 tonnes of one was mined at Renison, with a further 198,000 tonnes mined at Mt Bischoff, with 6267 tonnes of tin in concentrate being produced.

#### Tin Smelters in Tasmania

Tin smelting is carried out in a reverberatory furnace heated to 1200°C normally using coal for both heating and reducing tin oxide to tin metal. A tall chimney is required to provide a strong draught for the fire.

The Mt Bischoff Company built two smelters in Launceston in 1875. They operated for 55 years. The Stanhope Tin Mining Company built their smelters in Waratah in 1876 using local timber for heating and charcoal as the reducing agent. Hobart also had a tin smelter from 1877 to 1885, hoping to attract ore from the north east fields. The Tasmanian Tin Smelting Company built two furnaces in Launceston in 1878 and operated until 1887. The Anchor Tin Mining Company built a smelter at St Helens in 1900 but it only operated for 6 months.

#### Tin mining and Smelting in the South West.

The story of tin mining in South West Tasmania comes in three parts and two adjacent tin fields. The first part covers the entirely manual mining at Cox Bight on the south coast. The second part sees the introduction of some machinery at Melaleuca, some 12km inland near Port Davey. The third part sees larger machinery and an on-site smelter at Melaleuca.

Part 1: Tin was discovered in 1891 at Point Eric on Cox Bight. The soil and button grass were underlain by a bed of quartz gravel overlying bedrock, and the alluvial tin ore was in the gravel, increasing in quantity towards the bottom. Using mattocks, picks, shovels and forks, the gravel was removed from trenches 6 to 8 feet deep. In some places the gravel was so tightly packed that a stick of gelignite placed in a crowbar hole was needed to loosen the material.

In 1934 there were about 12 miners working their own claims and living in a big but built in the 1890s by the first company there, the Freney Prospecting Company. In 1936 Charles King started working on his own lease assisted by his son Deny.

Sluicing water was brought to the leases by channels from local creeks. The gravel rich in tin ore was washed down the sluice box with a nozzle and rakes, leaving the heavier tin behind. The tin ore was then bagged up for dispatch to Hobart by visiting fishing boats when the opportunity arose. Materials, equipment, supplies and mail came by the same means.

In 1934 the New Harbour Company was operating on a lease at Metaleuca which Chartie King and his son Deny took over in 1940, shortly before Deny enlisted for war service. Chartie continued working with little help at Cox Bight throughout the war. His output reached 3.5 tonnes of concentrate per annum which equated to 2.5 tonnes of tin. He also
