CHARACTERISTICS OF THE BODY PLAN

FUNCTIONAL TISSUE

- 1. **Epithelial Tissue** - Epithelial tissue is the most common type of tissue in the body. It is found on the surface of the body and lines the internal organs.
- 2. **Connective Tissue** - Connective tissue is the second most common type of tissue in the body. It is found throughout the body and provides support and structure.
- 3. **Muscle Tissue** - Muscle tissue is found in the body and is responsible for movement.
- 4. **Nervous Tissue** - Nervous tissue is found in the body and is responsible for transmitting information.

BODY PARTS AND REGIONS

- 1. **Head** - The head is the uppermost part of the body.
- 2. **Neck** - The neck is the part of the body between the head and the torso.
- 3. **Torso** - The torso is the middle part of the body.
- 4. **Arm** - The arm is the part of the body between the shoulder and the hand.
- 5. **Leg** - The leg is the part of the body between the hip and the foot.
- 6. **Foot** - The foot is the lowermost part of the body.

NERVOUS SYSTEM

FUNCTION

- 1. **Control** - The nervous system controls the body's activities.
- 2. **Coordination** - The nervous system coordinates the body's activities.
- 3. **Communication** - The nervous system communicates with the body's organs.
- 4. **Protection** - The nervous system protects the body's organs.
- 5. **Regulation** - The nervous system regulates the body's activities.

STRUCTURE

- 1. **Brain** - The brain is the central part of the nervous system.
- 2. **Spinal Cord** - The spinal cord is the part of the nervous system that runs down the back.
- 3. **Nerves** - Nerves are the part of the nervous system that carry messages between the brain and the rest of the body.

CELLS

- 1. **Neurons** - Neurons are the cells of the nervous system that carry messages.
- 2. **Glia** - Glia are the cells of the nervous system that support the neurons.

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ORGAN SYSTEM OF THE BODY

- 1. **Cardiovascular System** - The cardiovascular system is responsible for circulating blood throughout the body.
- 2. **Respiratory System** - The respiratory system is responsible for exchanging gases between the body and the environment.
- 3. **Digestive System** - The digestive system is responsible for breaking down food into nutrients that the body can use.
- 4. **Excretory System** - The excretory system is responsible for removing waste from the body.
- 5. **Reproductive System** - The reproductive system is responsible for producing offspring.
- 6. **Immune System** - The immune system is responsible for defending the body against disease.
- 7. **Endocrine System** - The endocrine system is responsible for regulating the body's activities.
- 8. **Nervous System** - The nervous system is responsible for controlling the body's activities.
- 9. **Musculoskeletal System** - The musculoskeletal system is responsible for movement and support.
- 10. **Integumentary System** - The integumentary system is responsible for protecting the body from the environment.

ORGANISMS

- 1. **Unicellular Organisms** - Unicellular organisms are organisms that consist of a single cell.
- 2. **Multicellular Organisms** - Multicellular organisms are organisms that consist of many cells.

CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE

- 1. **Organization** - Organisms are organized into a hierarchy of levels, from cells to the whole organism.
- 2. **Metabolism** - Organisms take in nutrients and energy and use them to produce energy and build up their bodies.
- 3. **Reproduction** - Organisms produce offspring that are like themselves.
- 4. **Growth** - Organisms grow and develop over time.
- 5. **Response** - Organisms respond to their environment.
- 6. **Adaptation** - Organisms adapt to their environment.
- 7. **Homeostasis** - Organisms maintain a stable internal environment.
- 8. **Evolution** - Organisms change over time.
