All Aunt Hagar's Children Edward P. Jones, 2009-10-13 In fourteen sweeping and sublime stories five of which have been published in *The New Yorker* the bestselling and Pulitzer Prize winning author of *The Known World* shows that his grasp of the human condition is firmer than ever Returning to the city that inspired his first prizewinning book *Lost in the City* Jones has filled this new collection with people who call Washington D C home Yet it is not the city's power brokers that most concern him but rather its ordinary citizens *All Aunt Hagar's Children* turns an unflinching eye to the men women and children caught between the old ways of the South and the temptations that await them further north people who in Jones's masterful hands emerge as fully human and morally complex whether they are country folk used to getting up with the chickens or people with centuries of education behind them In the title story in which Jones employs the first person rhythms of a classic detective story a Korean War veteran investigates the death of a family friend whose sorry destiny seems inextricable from his mother's own violent Southern childhood In *In the Blink of God's Eye* and *Tapestry* newly married couples leave behind the familiarity of rural life to pursue lives of urban promise only to be challenged and disappointed With the legacy of slavery just a stone's throw away and the future uncertain Jones's cornucopia of characters will haunt readers for years to come

All Aunt Hagar's Children Edward P. Jones, 2006 **Reimagining Hagar** Nyasha Junior, 2019

Reimagining Hagar illustrates that while interpretations of Hagar as Black are not frequent within the entire history of her interpretation such interpretations are part of strategies to emphasize elements of Hagar's story in order to associate or disassociate her from particular groups It considers how interpreters engage markers of difference including gender ethnicity status and their intersections in their portrayals of Hagar Nyasha Junior offers a reception history that examines interpretations of Hagar with a focus on interpretations of Hagar as a Black woman Reception history within biblical studies considers the use impact and influence of biblical texts and looks at a necessarily small number of points within the long history of the transmission of biblical texts This volume covers a limited selection of interpretations over time that is not intended to be a representative sample of interpretations of Hagar It is beyond the scope of this book to offer a comprehensive collection of interpretations of Hagar throughout the history of biblical interpretation or in popular culture Junior argues for the African presence in biblical texts identifies and responds to White supremacist interpretations offers cultural historical interpretation that attends to the history of biblical interpretation within Black communities and provides ideological criticism that uses the African American context as a reading strategy *Reimagining Hagar* offers a history of interpretation but also expands beyond interpretation among Black communities to consider how various interpreters have identified Hagar as Black

The Geographies of African American Short Fiction Kenton Rambsy, 2022-03-25 Perhaps the brevity of short fiction accounts for the relatively scant attention devoted to it by scholars who have historically concentrated on longer prose narratives *The Geographies of African American Short Fiction* seeks to fill this gap by analyzing the ways African American short story writers plotted a diverse range of characters across multiple locations small towns a famous metropolis city sidewalks a rural wooded area apartment buildings a pond a general store a prison and more In the process these writers highlighted the extents to which places and spaces shaped or situated racial representations Presenting African American short story writers as cultural cartographers author Kenton Rambsy documents the variety of geographical references within their short stories to show how these authors make cultural spaces integral to their artwork and inscribe their stories with layered and resonant social histories The history of these short stories also documents the circulation of compositions across dozens of literary collections for nearly a century Anthology editors solidified the significance of a core group of short story authors including James Baldwin Toni Cade Bambara Charles Chesnutt Ralph Ellison Zora Neale Hurston and Richard Wright Using quantitative information and an extensive literary dataset *The Geographies of African American Short Fiction* explores how editorial practices shaped the canon of African American short fiction Hagar, Sarah, And Their Children Letty M.

Russell, In different ways Judaism Christianity and Islam all trace their beginnings to Abraham His wives Hagar and Sarah though also pivotal in the story have received far less attention In this book however noted Jewish Christian and Muslim scholars focus on Hagar Sarah and their children from Ishmael and Isaac to their many descendents through the centuries Moving from ancient and medieval sources to contemporary appropriations of the Sarah and Hagar story the authors begin with an overview of the three religions from their scriptural beginnings to their contemporary questions They then explore how the story was developed after its canonization in rabbinic interpretations in the stories of Islam and in the teachings of the early church fathers They also present contemporary womanist and feminist perspectives Timely relevant and provocative this book provides an entree into interreligious discussion and understanding

Understanding Edward P. Jones James W. Coleman, 2016-07-15 A comprehensive survey of the works of an acclaimed African American writer In *Understanding Edward P. Jones* James W. Coleman analyzes Jones's award winning works as well as the significant influences that have shaped his craft Born and raised in Washington D C Jones has made that city and its African American community the subject of or background for most of his fiction Though Jones's first work was published in 1976 his career developed slowly While he worked for two decades as a proofreader and abstractor Jones published short fiction in such periodicals as *Essence* the *New Yorker* and *Paris Review* His first collection *Lost in the City* won the PEN Hemingway Award and subsequent books including *The Known World* and *All Aunt Hagar's Children* received similar accolades including the

National Book Critics Circle Award and the Pulitzer Prize for Fiction Following an overview of Jones's life influences and career Coleman provides an introduction to the technique of Jones's fiction which he likens to a tapestry woven of intricate varied and sometimes disparate elements He then analyzes the formal structure themes and characters of *The Known World* and devotes a chapter each to the short story collections *Lost in the City* and *All Aunt Hagar's Children* His discussion of these volumes focuses on Jones's narrative technique the themes of family community and broader tradition and the connections through which the stories in each volume collectively create a thematic whole In his final chapter Coleman assesses Jones's encompassing outlook that sees African American life in distinct periods but also as a historical whole simultaneously in the future the past and the present

The Raceless Antiracist Sheena Michele Mason, 2024-10-17 Many scholars and activists argue that the practice of racialization and the belief in race are necessary because even if race is not real racism is While such an approach might help lessen some effects of racism it inevitably strengthens the very foundation of racism As Sheena Michele Mason argues in *The Raceless Antiracist* fighting racism by ignoring or upholding the idea of race and the practice of racialization is like trying to stop a flood by dousing it with water To end racism particularly antiblack racism we must question acknowledge and translate race as an integral part of racism itself In presenting her case for charting a future without racism Mason weaves insights from philosophy sociology statistics biology history and literary studies She presents a map which she refers to as the togetherness wayfinder for how to discuss teach identify and stop the causes and effects of racism without hardening any of its components With this guide we can end the idea of race and the practice of racialization and start to navigate more effectively toward a post racist world
