of the skin, fibrous in texture, and they are anchored to the nosal bane. Neither of the types mentioned, those of the deer or the rhinoceros, are horns in the true sense of the word. In the ax and antelope families, however, and also in the sheep and goots, the growths are horn in the true sense. In these animals the horns are horny sheaths supported by bony cores, firmly attached to the skull. They are not shed and protuberances or care of the deer. It is only horns of this kind, consisting of hellow and unbranched sheaths of horn growing upon bony protuberances or cores arising from the frontal banes, that are regarded as true horns. In all the wild species of exen the horns are present at least in the male sex, but in some domestic breeds of cattle, sheep and goots, they are absent in both sexes. As can be seen from the drawings, the horns vary very much in shape as well as in thickness, some actually taking a carkscrew form while others are branched to varying extents
