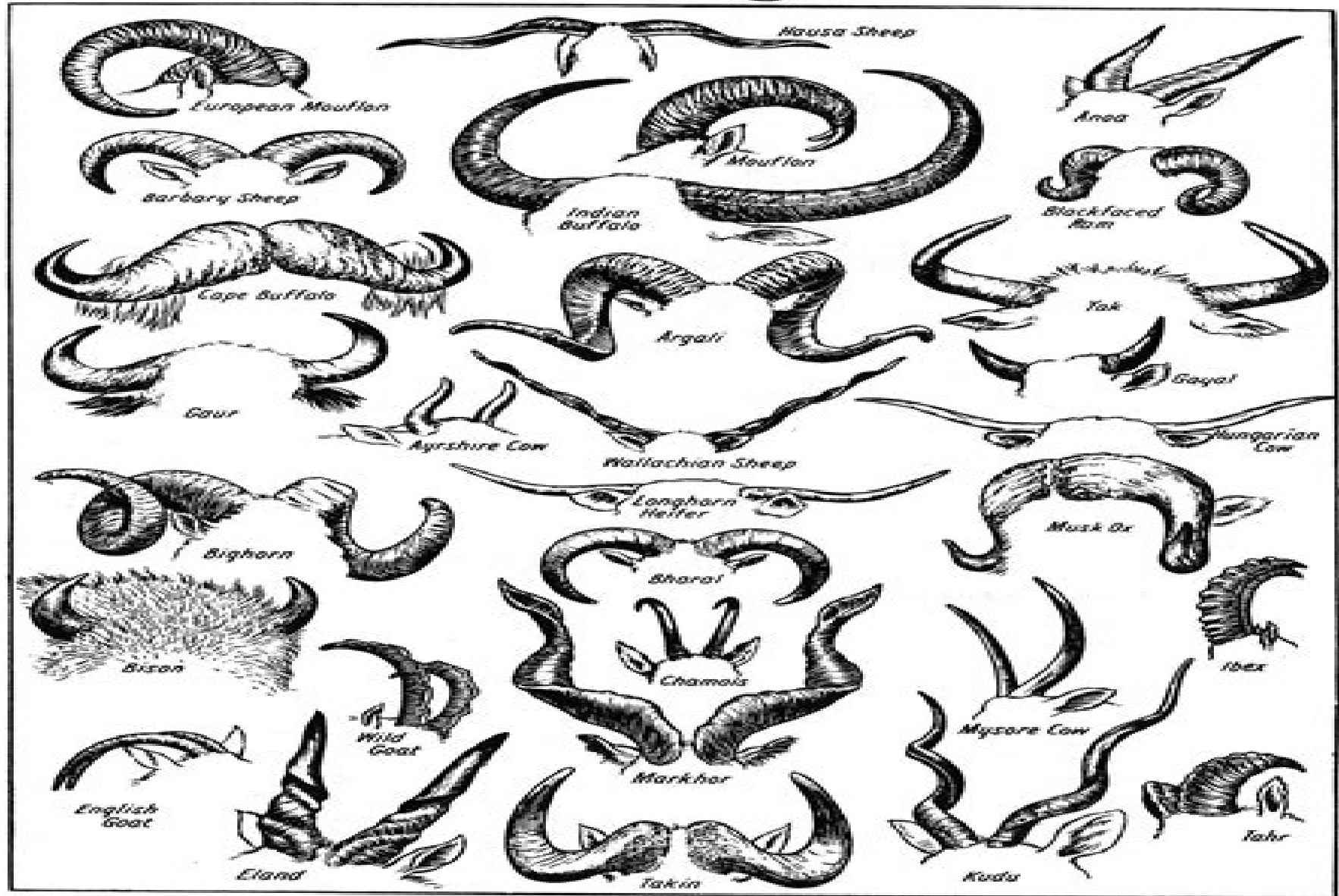

of the skin, fibrous in texture, and they are anchored to the nasal bone. Neither of the types mentioned, those of the deer or the rhinoceros, are horns in the true sense of the word. In the ox and antelope families, however, and also in the sheep and goats, the growths are horns in the true sense. In these animals the horns are horny sheaths supported by bony cores, firmly attached to the skull. They are not shed and renewed as in the case of the deer. It is only horns of this kind, consisting of hollow and unbranched sheaths of horn growing upon bony protuberances or cores arising from the frontal bones, that are regarded as true horns. In all the wild species of oxen the horns are present at least in the male sex, but in some domestic breeds of cattle, sheep and goats, they are absent in both sexes. As can be seen from the drawings, the horns vary very much in shape as well as in thickness, some actually taking a corkscrew form while others are branched to varying extents
