

- Look for slight chest incomment with each breath.
- Use CO, detector after intubation.
- Accepts a poulse optimister.

CB Circulation

- Start compressions if HR is odd after 30 seconds of effective PPV
- Give (3 compressions: 5 breath) every 2 seconds.
- Compress one third of the anterior posterior diameter of the chest

- Give epinephrine if HR is <00 after 45 to 60 seconds of compressions. and vertillation
- Caution: epinephrine dosage is different for ET and N routes
