Attempt to wake the victim and call for help. If the victim is not and call for help. Breathing (or is just gasping for breath), call 911 immediately and go



Begin chest compressions.

If the victim is not breathing, place the heel of your hand in the middle of his chest. Put your other hand on top of the first with your fingers interfaced. Compress the chest at least 2 inches (4-5 cm). Allow the chest to completely recoil before the next compression. Compress the chest at a rate of at least 100 pushes per minute. Perform 30 compresslooks at this rate.

Open the airway.

After 30 compressions, open the victim's airway using the head-tilt, chin-lift method. Pinch the victim's nose and make a seal over the victim's mouth with yours. Use a CPR mask if available.



Begin rescue breaths.

Give the victim a breath, just enough to make the chest rise. Let the chest fall, then repeat the rescue breath once more. If the chest deesn't rise on the first breath, reposition the head and try again. Whether it works on the second try or not, go to step 5.

Repeat chest compressions.



Repeat rescue breaths.

Repeat rescue breaths. Give more breaths just like you did in step 4 (unless you're skipping the rescue breaths). Repeat steps 5 and 6 for about two minutes (about 5 cycles of 30 compressions and 2 rescue breaths).
