



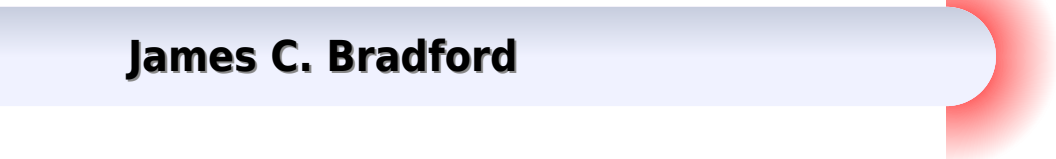
Interior of the old Jersey Prison Ship, in the Revolutionary War.

America's Captives Paul J. Springer, 2010-03-17 Notwithstanding the long shadows cast by Abu Ghraib and Guantanamo the United States has been generally humane in the treatment of prisoners of war reflecting a desire to both respect international law and provide the kind of treatment we would want for our own troops if captured In this first comprehensive study of the subject in more than half a century Paul Springer presents an in depth look at American POW policy and practice from the Revolutionary War to the current wars in Iraq and Afghanistan Springer contends that our nation's creation and application of POW policy has been repeatedly improvised and haphazard due in part to our military's understandable focus on defeating its enemies on the field of battle rather than on making arrangements for their detention That focus however has set the

conditions for the military's chronic failure to record and learn from both successful and unsuccessful POW practices in previous wars. He also observes that American POW policy since World War II has largely sought to outsource POW operations to allied forces in order to retain American personnel for frontline service outsourcing that has led to recent scandals. Focusing on each major war in turn, Springer examines the lessons learned and forgotten by American military and political leaders regarding our nation's experience in dealing with foreign POWs. He highlights the indignities of the Civil War, the efforts of the United States and its World War I allies to devise an effective POW policy, the unequal treatment of Japanese prisoners compared with that of German and Italian prisoners during World War II, and the impact of the Geneva Convention on the handling of Korean and Vietnamese captives. In bringing his coverage up to the so-called War on Terror, he also marks the nation's clear departure from previous practice. American treatment of POWs, once deemed exemplary by the Red Cross after Operation Desert Storm, has become controversial throughout the world. *A Companion to American Military History* provides a long needed overarching framework for this important subject and makes a strong case that we should stop ignoring the lessons of the past and make the disposition of prisoners one of the standard components of our military education and training.

British Supporters of the American Revolution, 1775-1783 Sheldon Samuel Cohen, 2004 America's Declaration of Independence while endeavouring to justify a break with Great Britain simultaneously proclaimed that the colonists had not been wanting in attention to our British brethren but that they had been deaf to the voice of justice and consanguinity This overstatement has since been modified in comprehensive histories of the American Revolution Gradually a more balanced portrait of British attitudes towards the conflict has emerged In particular studies of pro American Britons have exemplified this fact by concentrating on only a small upper class minority In contrast this work focuses on five unrenowned men of Britain's middling orders These individuals actively endeavoured to aid the American cause Their efforts often unlawful brought them into contact with Benjamin Franklin for whom they befriended rebel seamen confined in British gaols Their stories rendered here open up new areas for study of the American War on this middling segment of Britain's social structure

Yankee Sailors in British Gaols Sheldon Samuel Cohen, 1995 Yankee Sailors in British Gaols offers the first comprehensive account of American servicemen detained within the confines of Mill and Forton prisons the principal land based detention centers in Britain during the American Revolution Forton and Mill during the course of the War of Independence held approximately 3 000 American prisoners almost all of them naval personnel In a few cases these American prisoners were incarcerated for more than four years a longer recorded period of incarceration in overseas prisons than in any United States war prior to Vietnam Professor Cohen's examination of wide ranging and widely scattered primary and secondary sources provides an extraordinarily detailed picture of life within the closed society of each prison as well as insight into the various ways in which Britons and Americans outside the prisons provided legal and extralegal help to the rebel detainees

argues that smallpox played an integral role in military affairs for both the British and Continental armies and impacted soldiers and civilians throughout the War for American Independence Due to the Royal army s policy of troop inoculation and because many British soldiers were already immune to the variola virus the American army was initially at a disadvantage Most American colonists were highly susceptible to this dreaded disease and its presence was greatly feared General George Washington was keenly aware of this disadvantage and despite his own doubts embarked on a policy of inoculation to protect his troops Use of this controversial innovative and effective medical procedure leveled the playing field within the armies However by 1777 smallpox spread throughout America as soldiers interacted with civilian populations Once military action moved south American and British auxiliary troops and the enslaved Southern population all succumbed to the disease creating a disorderly dangerous situation as the war ends Washington s implementation of isolation policies as well as mass troop inoculation removed the threat of epidemic smallpox and ultimately protected American soldiers and civilians from the dangers of this much feared disease
