ENLIGHTENMENT ERA (1600 – 1800)

- The Enlightenment was a 17th century intellectual movement.
- It worked to limit the power of monarch governments (kings and queens) and religious leaders.
- Other important Enlightenment ideas include popular sovereignty and natural rights.
- John Locke believed the job of government was to protect the rights of people or be overthrown, and his ideas greatly influenced the American colonists.
- Major Enlightenment thinkers:
 - Locke = Natural Rights
 - Montesquieu = Separation of Powers
 - Voltaire = Freedom of Speech
- Enlightenment ideas led to the American Revolutionary War, the Declaration of Independence, U.S. Constitution, Bill of Rights, and the French Revolution.

INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION (CONTINUED)

- Urbanization led to several negative effects:
 - Pollution
 - Dangerous working conditions
 - Long hours and low wages
 - Child labor
 - Slums and poor housing conditions
 - Cramped living spaces and rampant diseases
- Labor unions formed to combat terrible working conditions in factories and sought better pay, shorter hours, and improved conditions.
- Henry Ford – founder of the Ford Motor Company – used the assembly line to produce his cars fast and cheap. This revolutionized manufacturing and gave rise to specialized labor.

INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION (1750 – 1900)

- The Industrial Revolution took place in the late 1700s in Europe and in the early 1800s in America, and it was a time of technological innovation.
- Improved agricultural technology, like steam-powered tractors and large-scale food processing factories led to increased food yields.
- Railroad linked cities, brought materials to factories more efficiently, increased trade between cities and countries, and allowed people to move more freely.
- Many people moved from rural areas to cities to find work in newly built factories, a movement known as urbanization.
