Alliteration is the repetition of the first consonant sound in words. You can use these sentences to create a poem. Good examples are tongue twister such as:

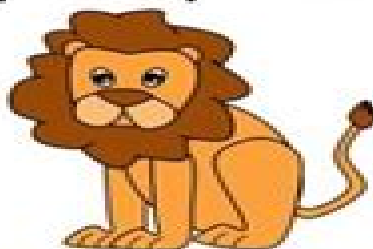
*Peter Piper picked a pack of pickled
